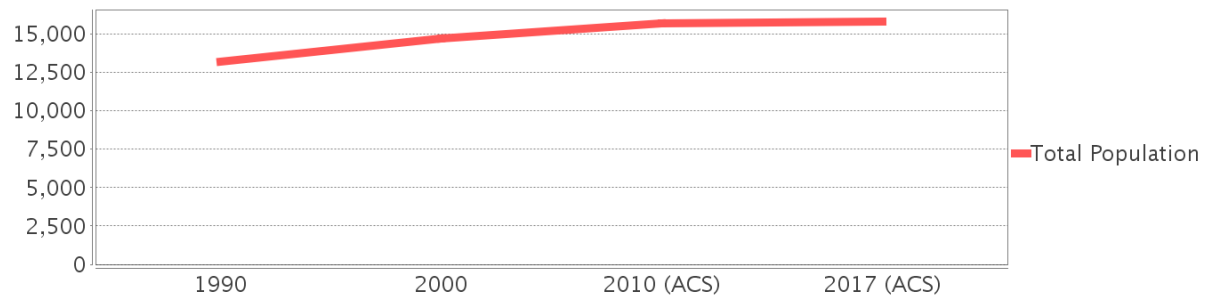

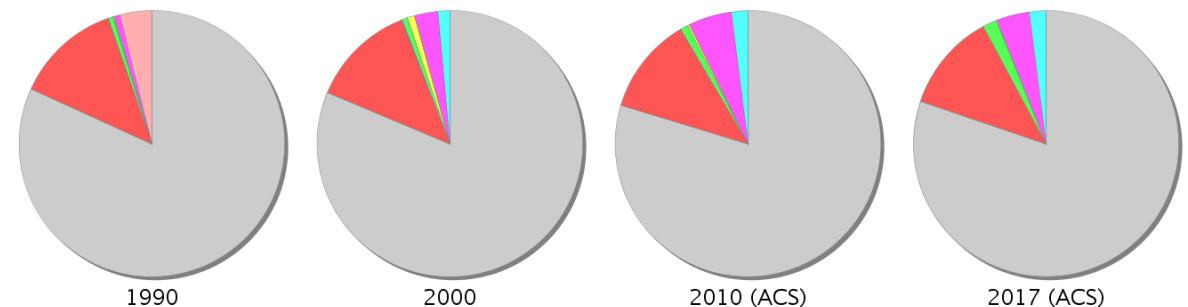

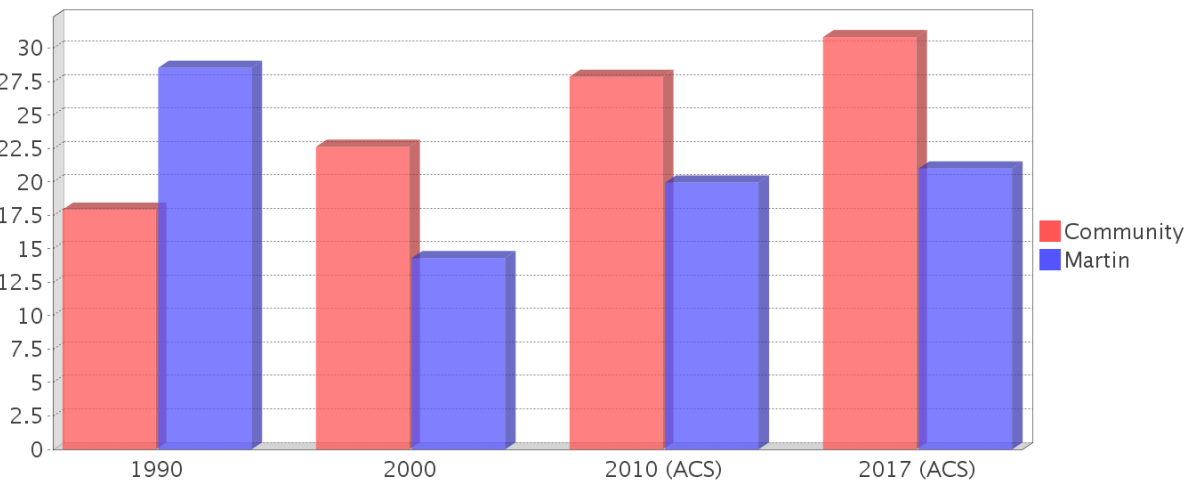

Race



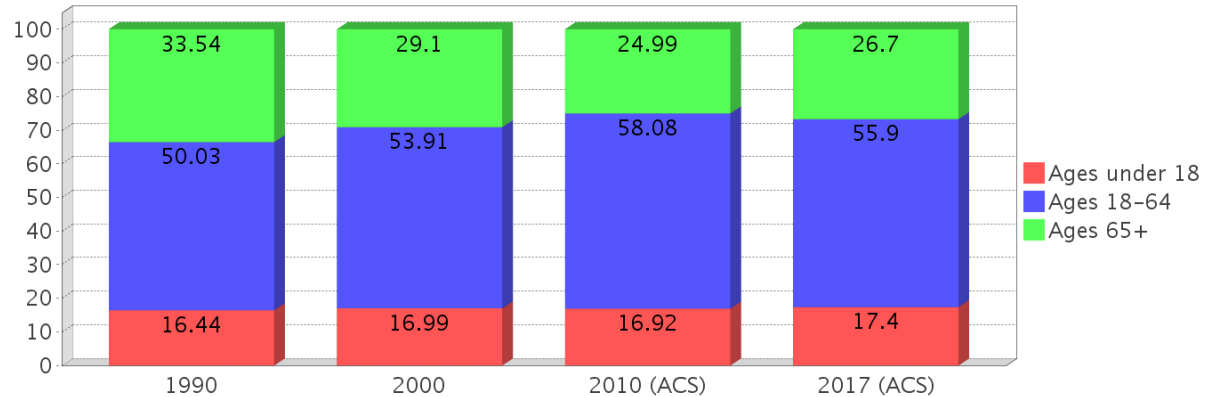

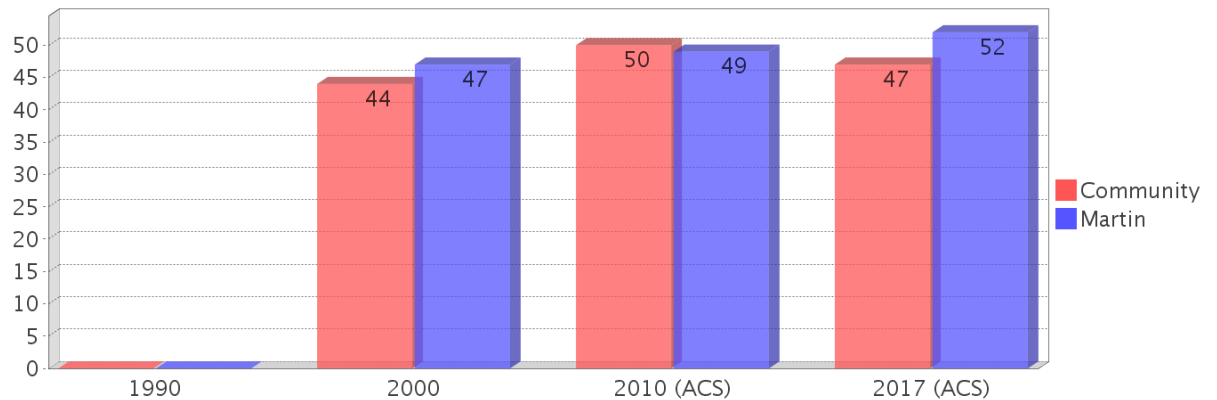
Percentage Population by Age Group

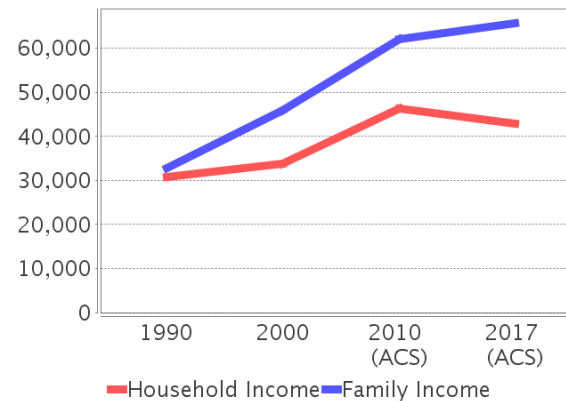

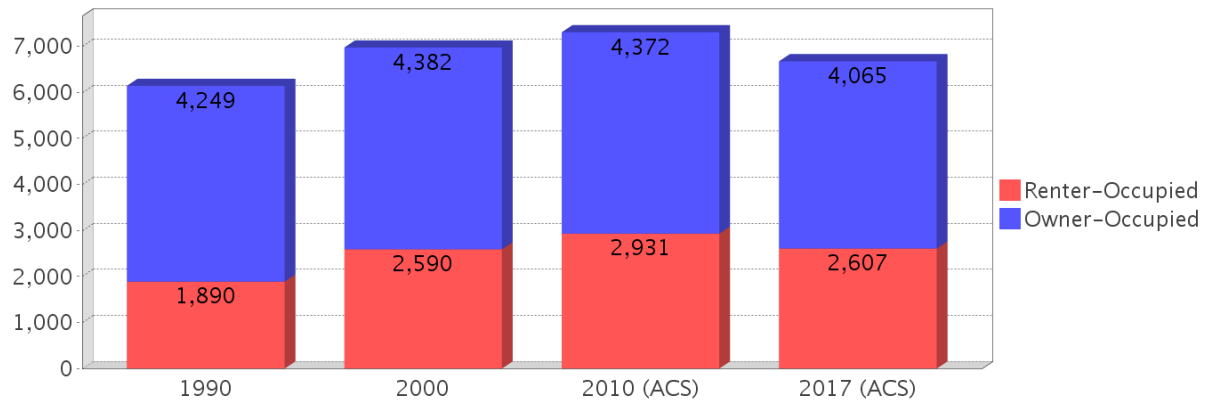

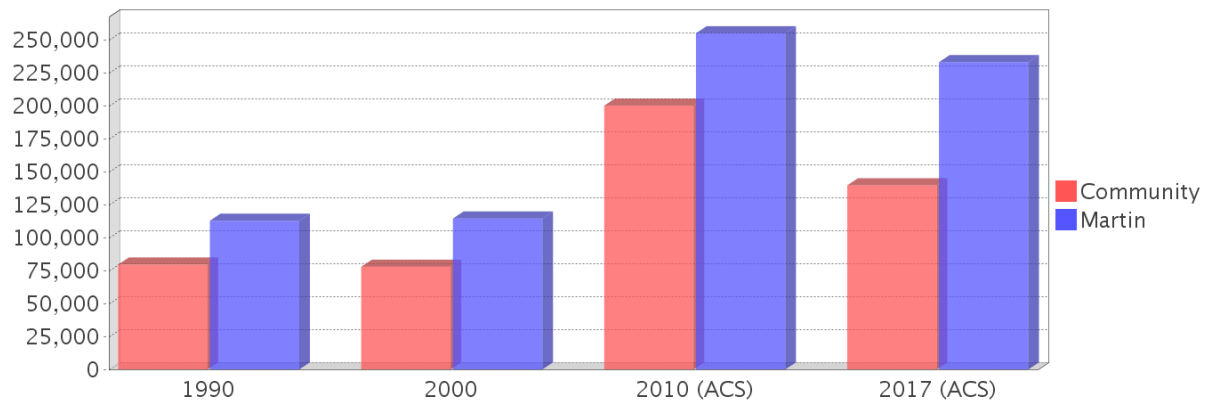

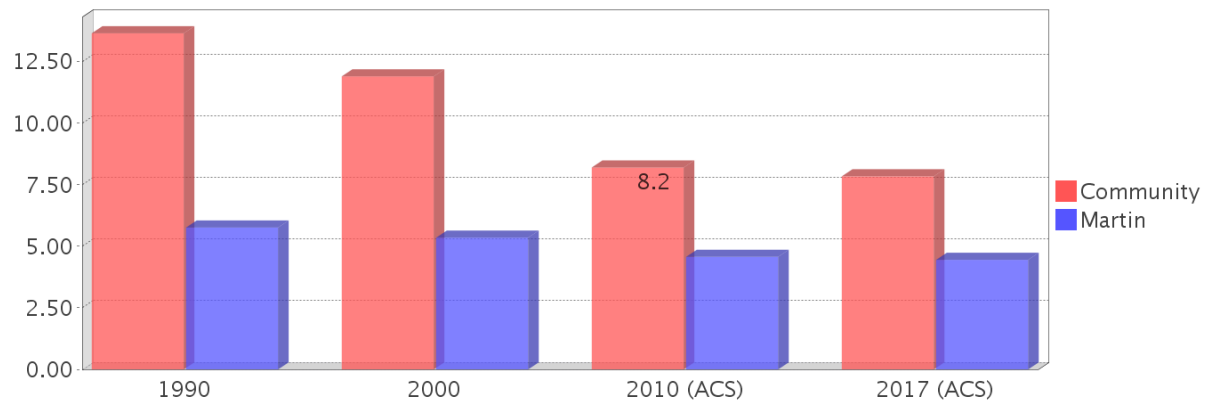
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

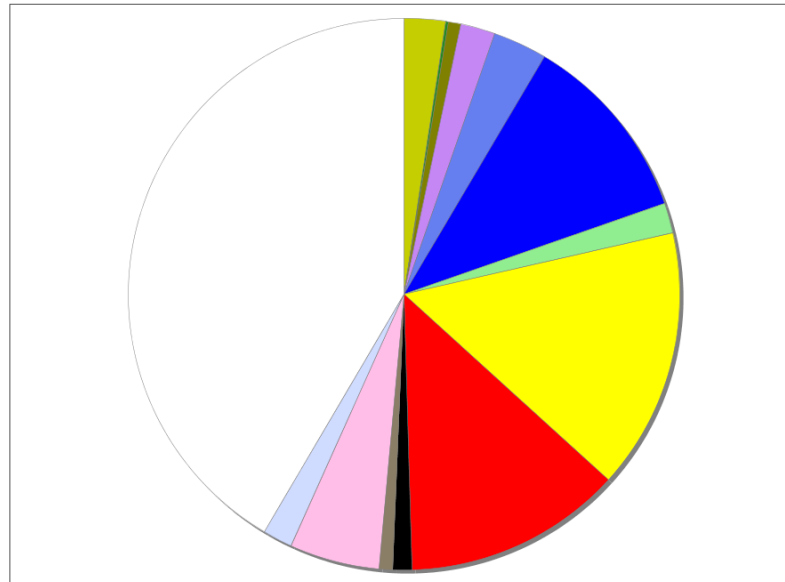


Occupied Units With No Vehicles Available



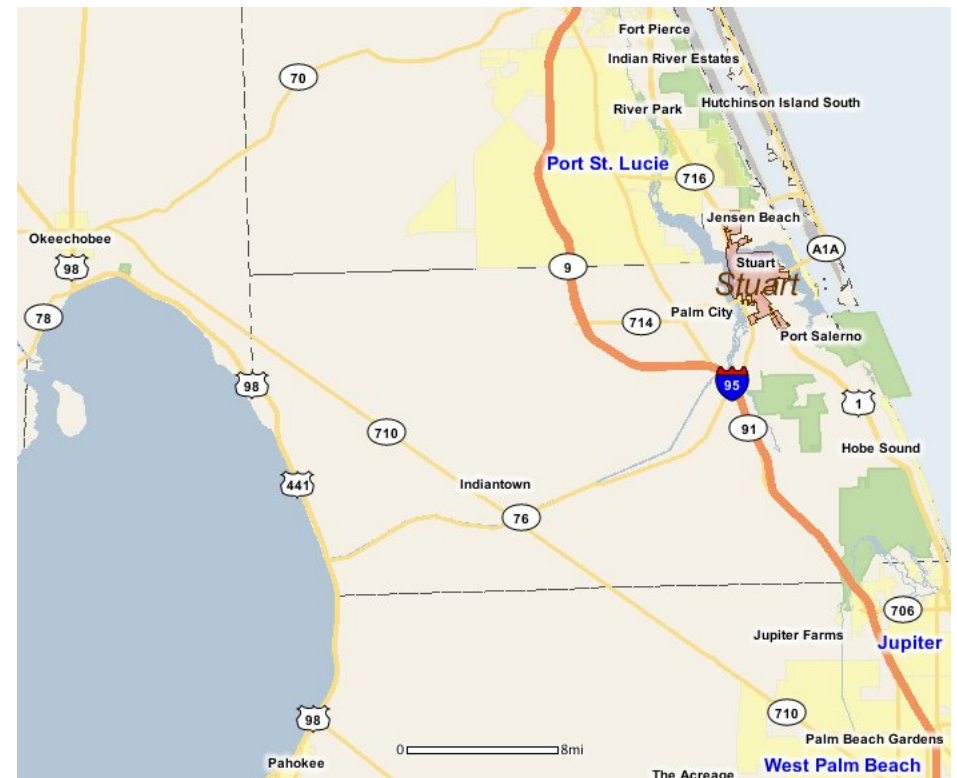
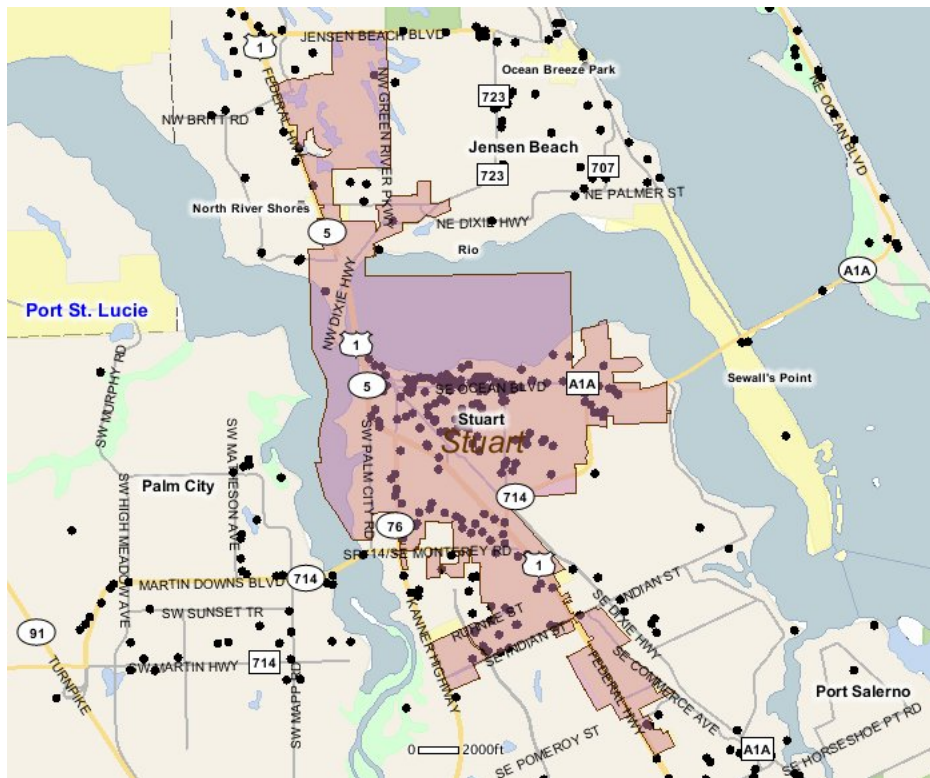

About the Census Data:

population. To improve the accuracy of such estimates in the SDR report, the census block group data was adjusted to exclude all census blocks with a population of two or fewer. These areas were eliminated from the corresponding years' block groups. Next, the portion of the block group that lies outside of the community or AOI boundary was removed. 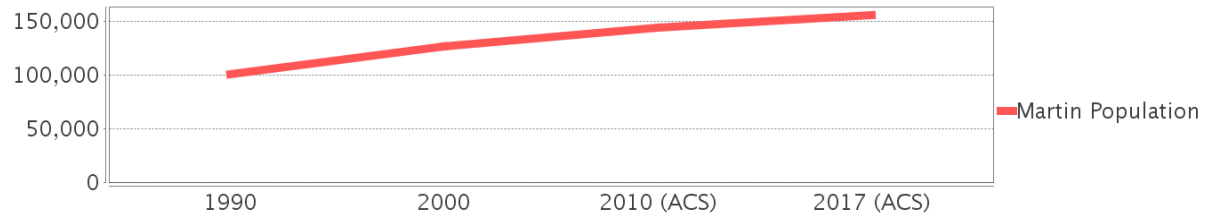

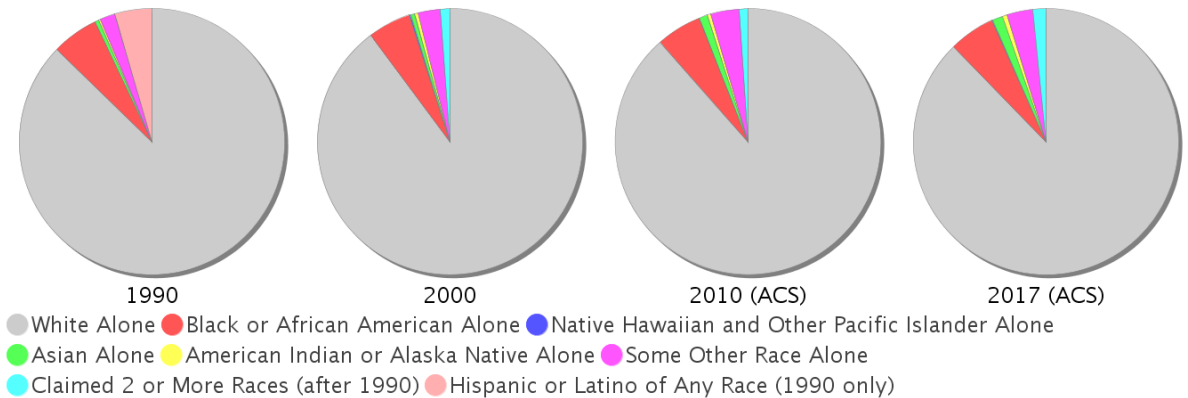

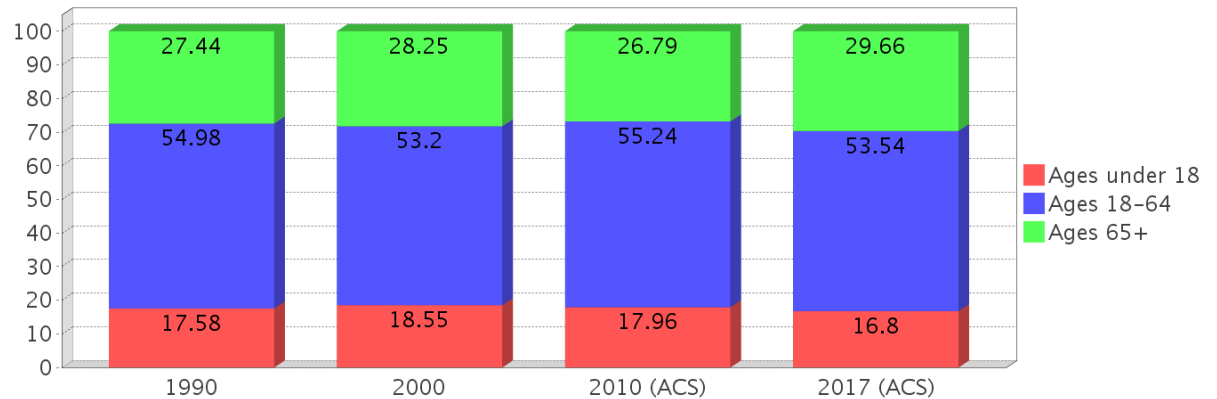

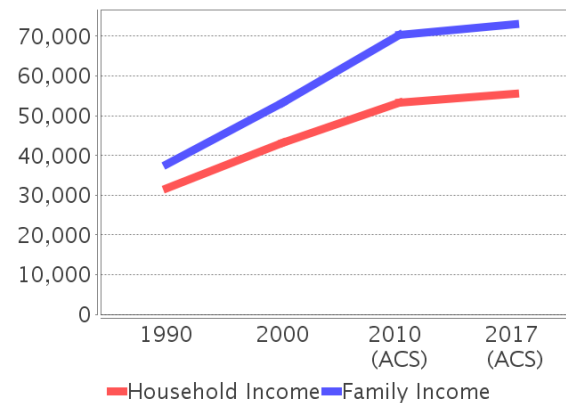
Percentage Population by Age Group - Martin



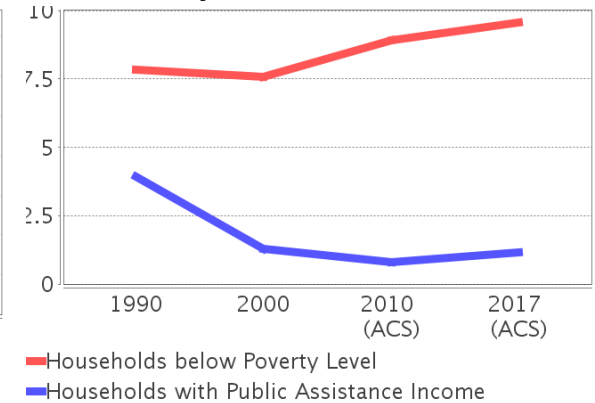

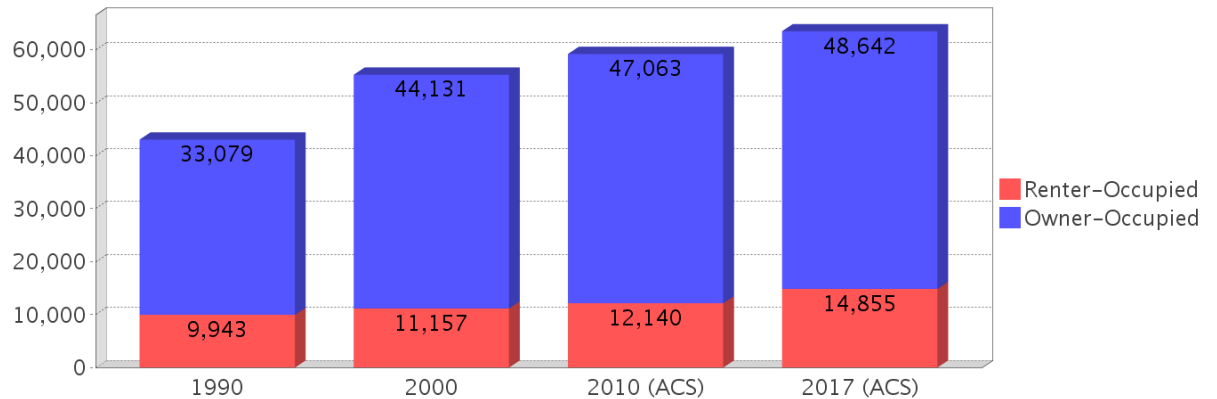
