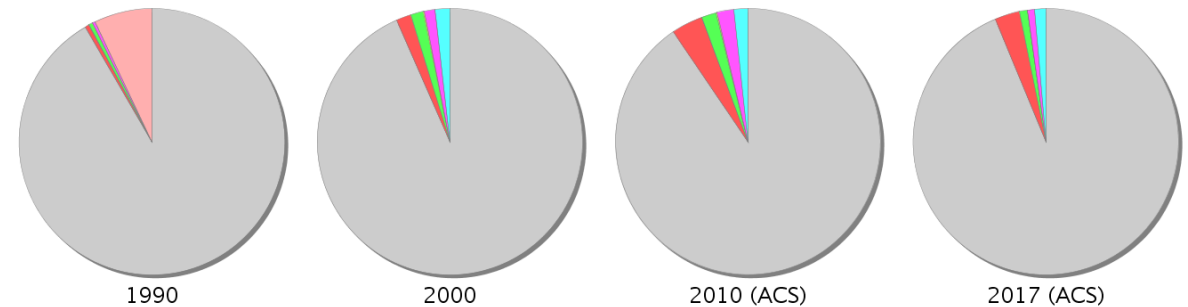

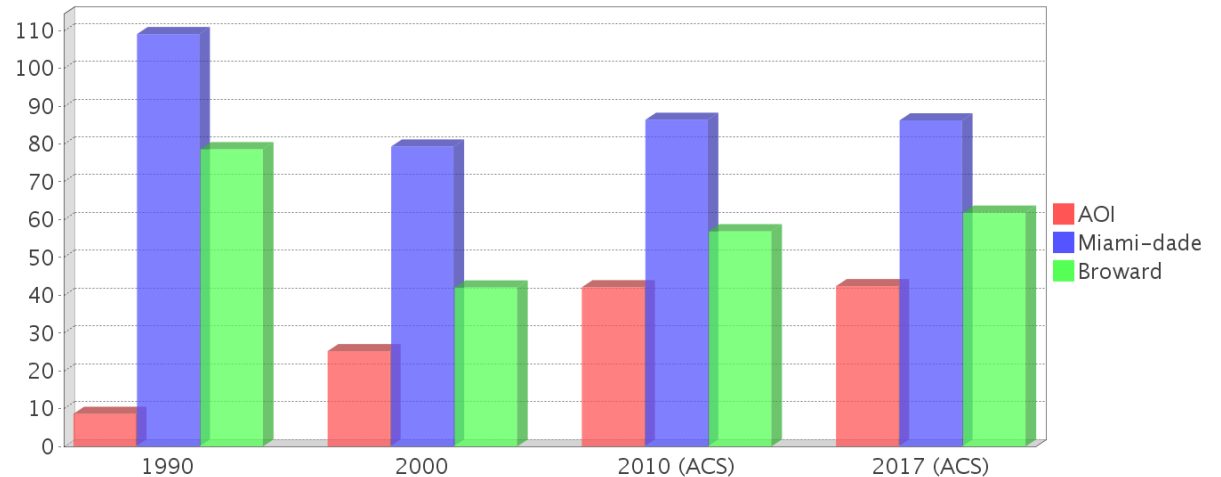

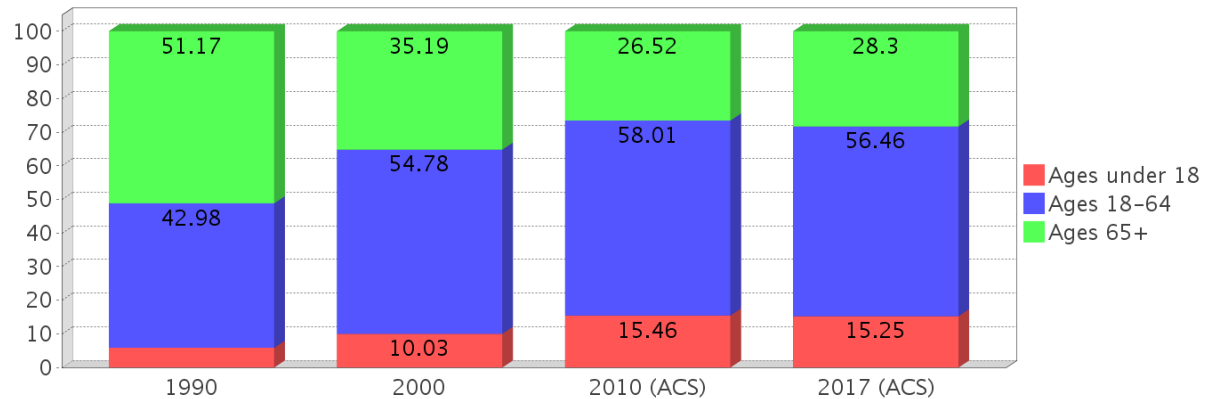

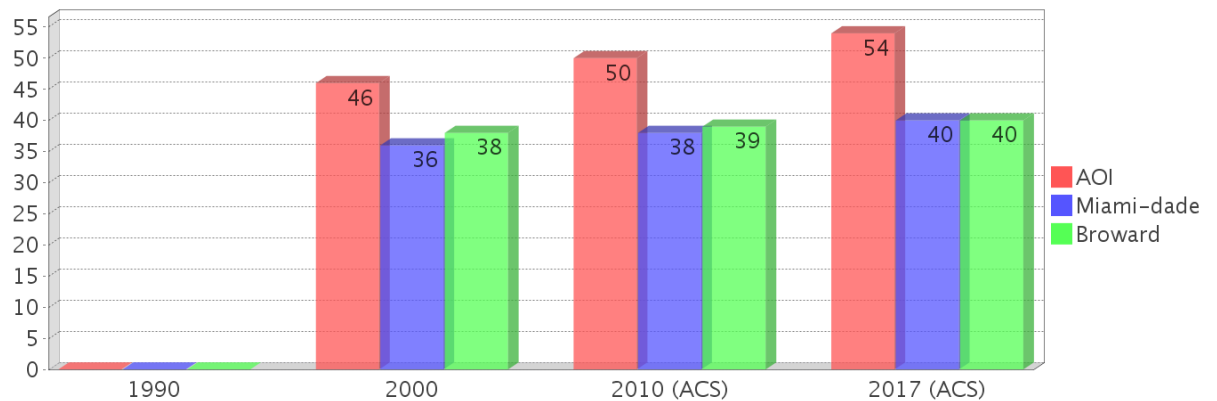
Percentage Population by Age Group

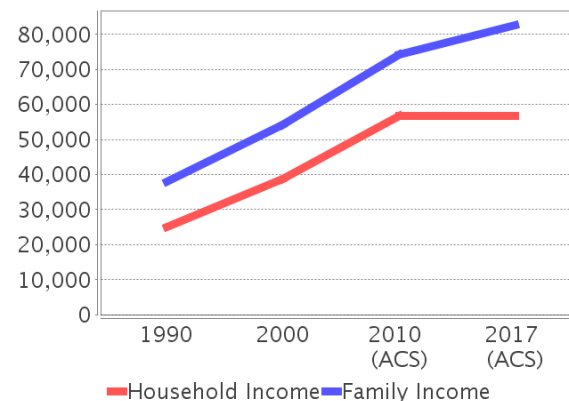

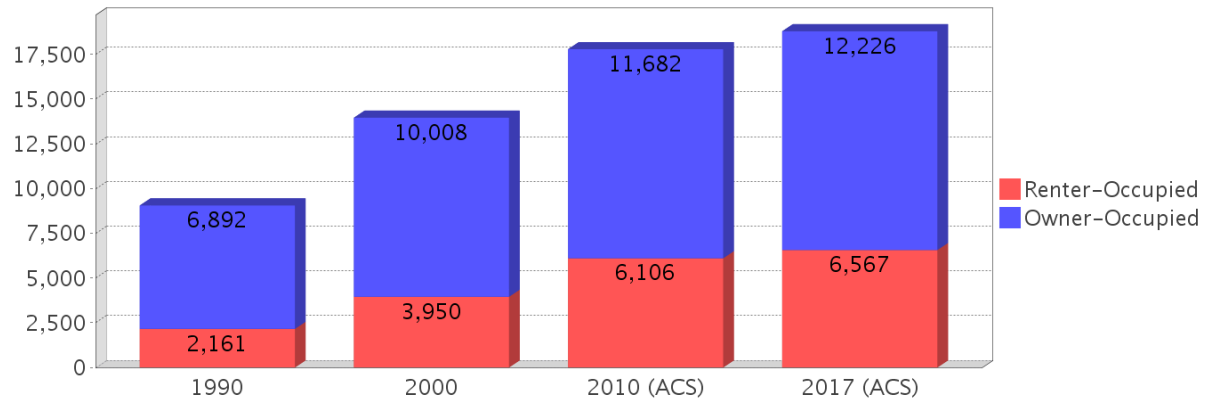

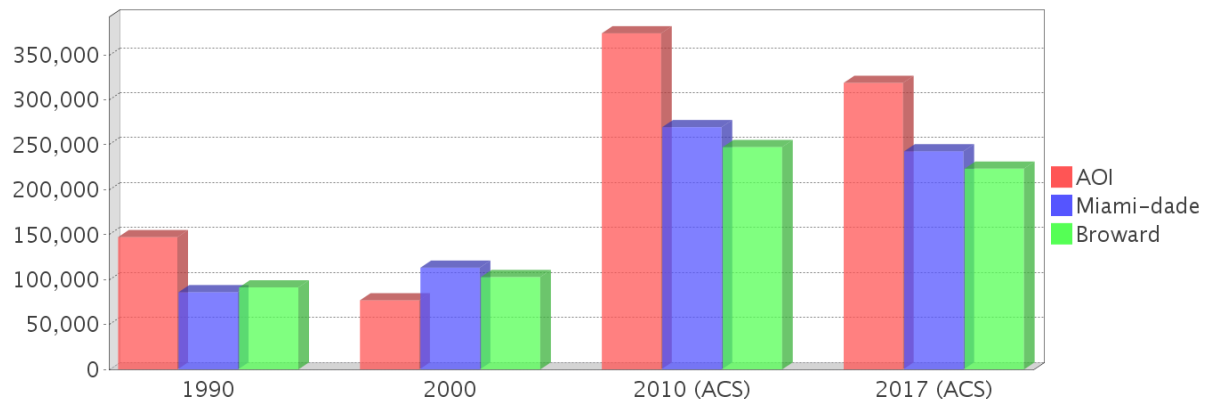

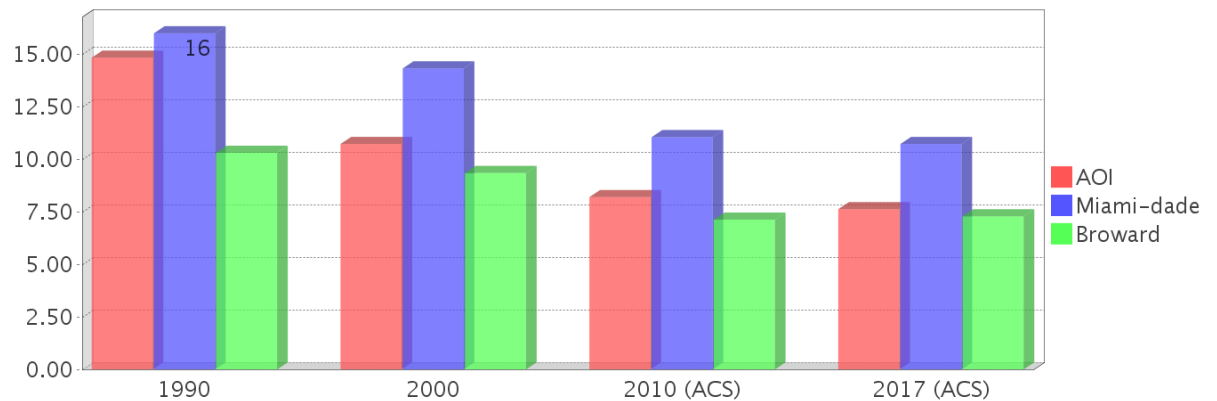
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

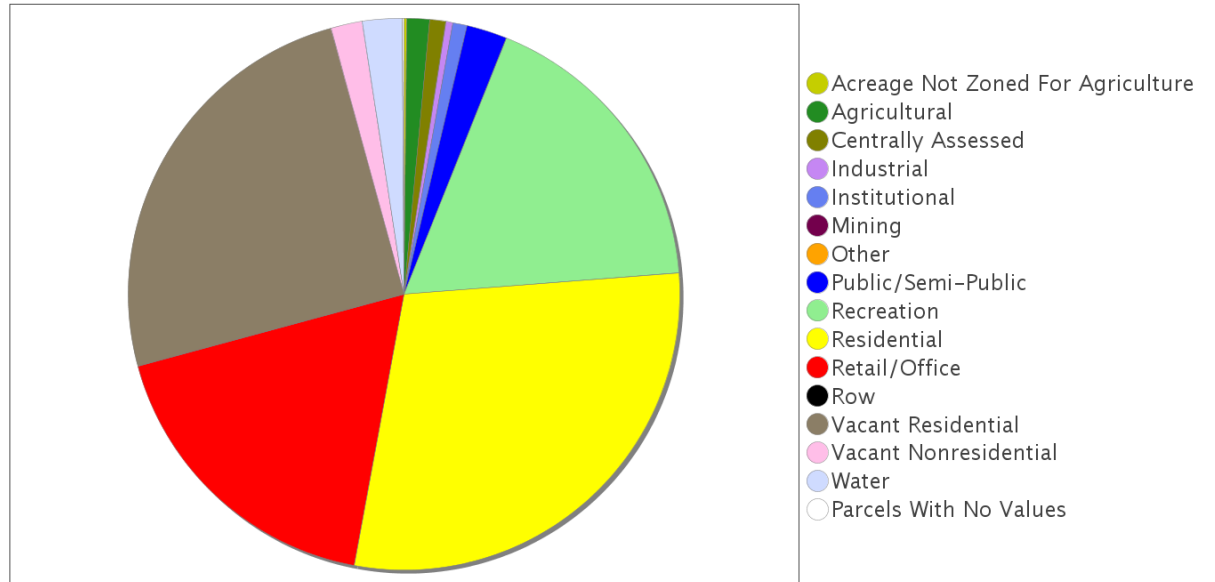

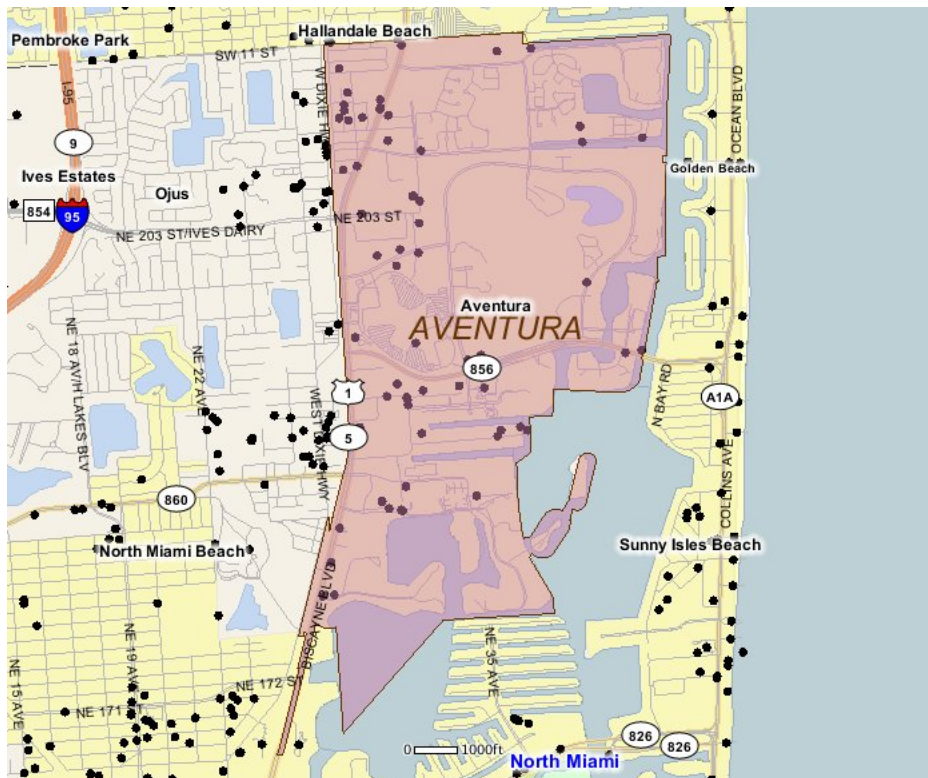

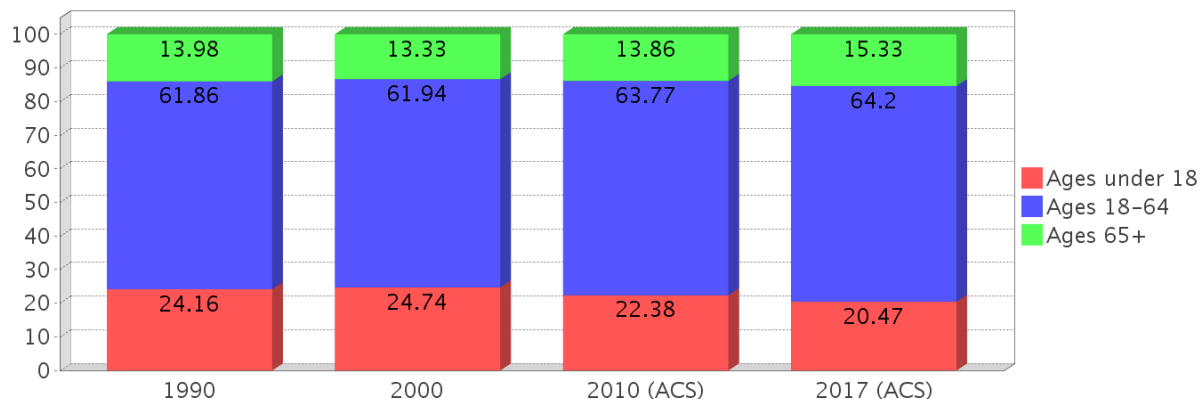

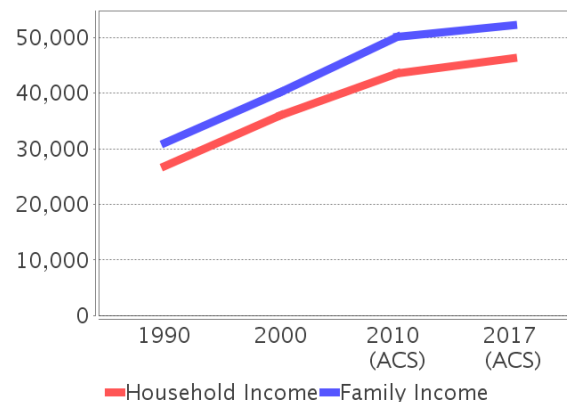
Percentage Population by Age Group - Miami-dade



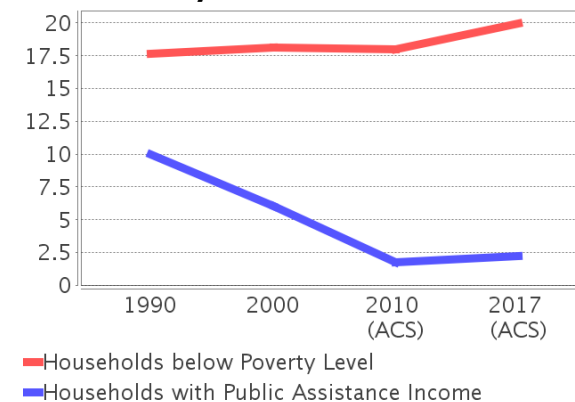

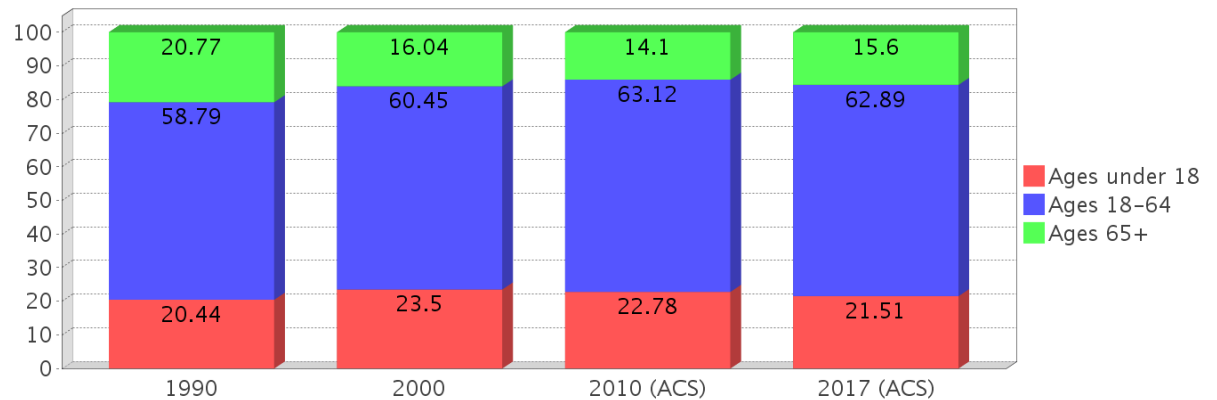

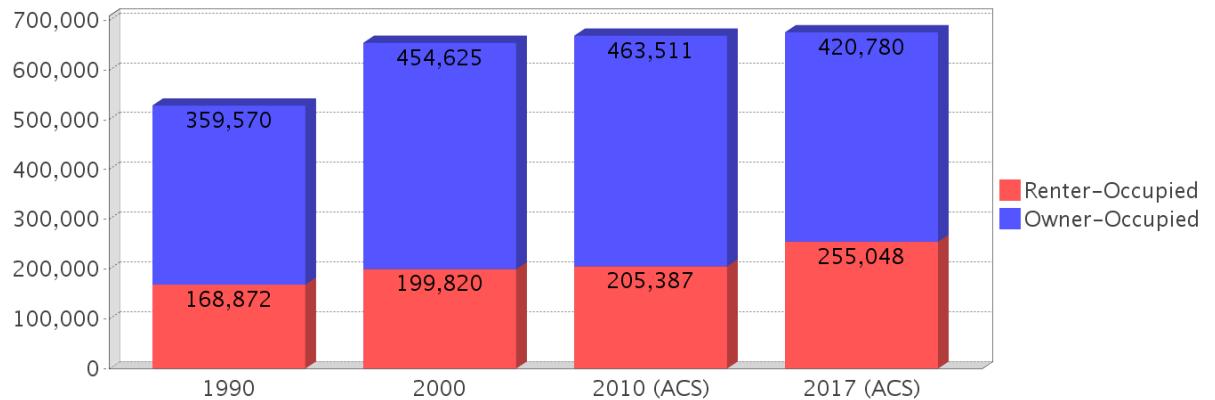
