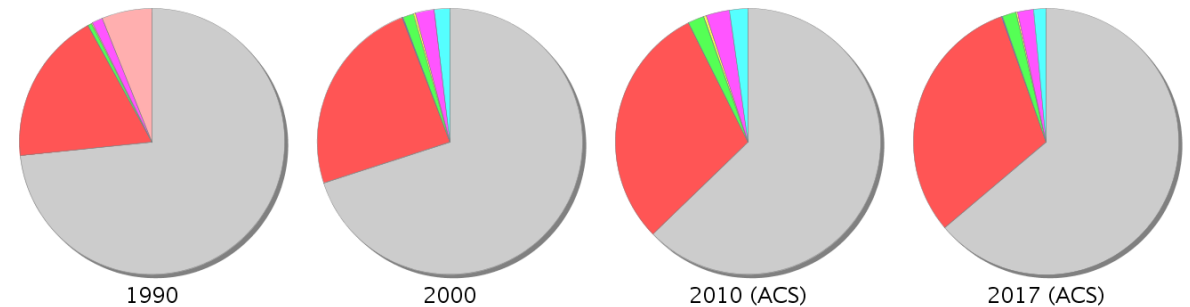

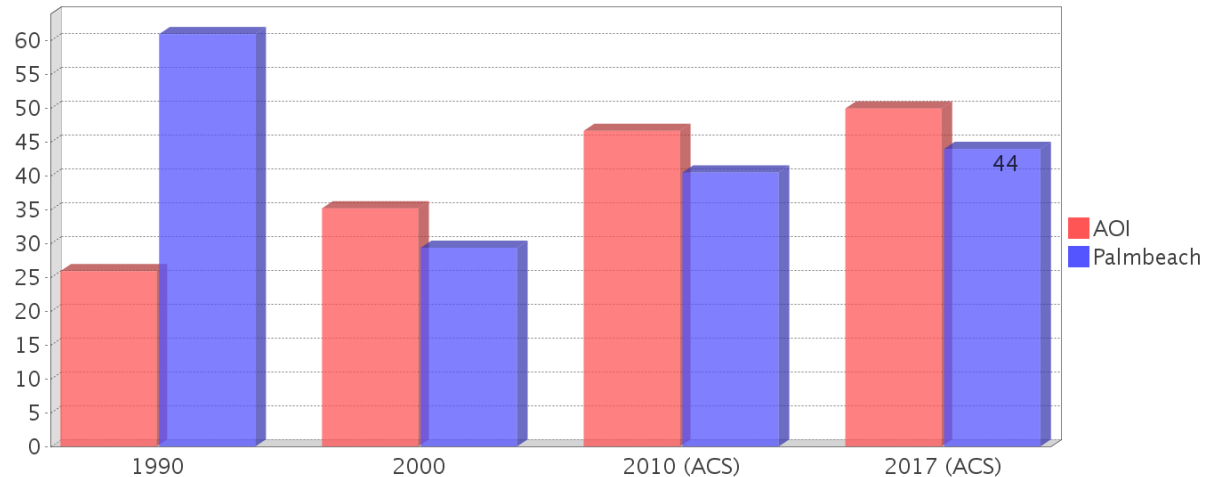

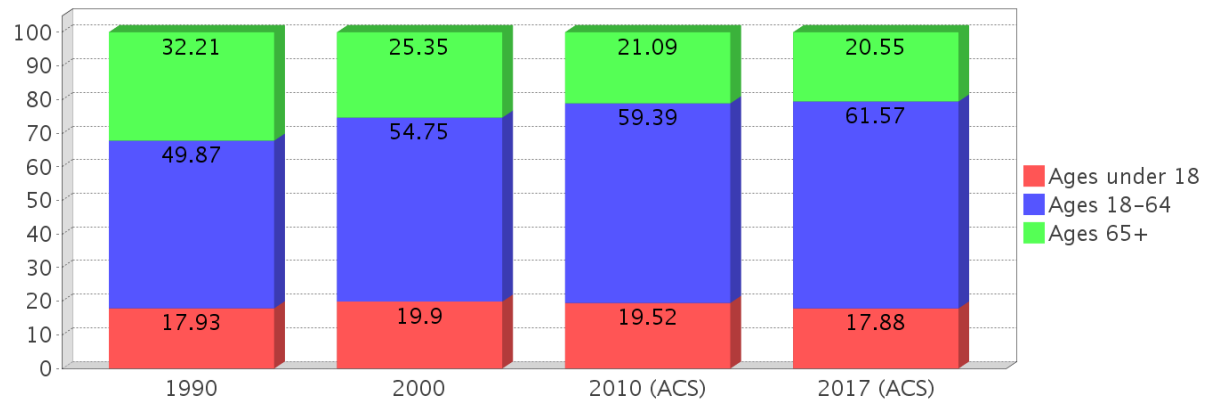

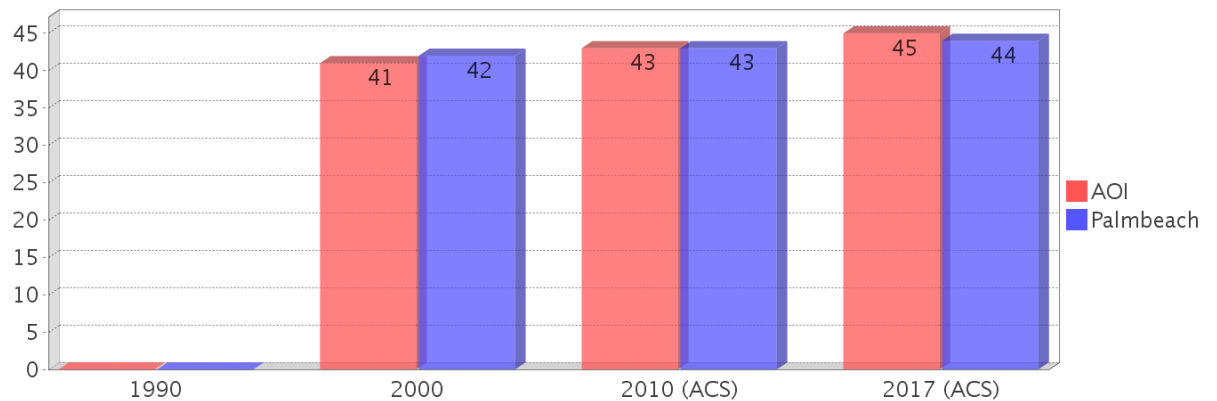
Percentage Population by Age Group

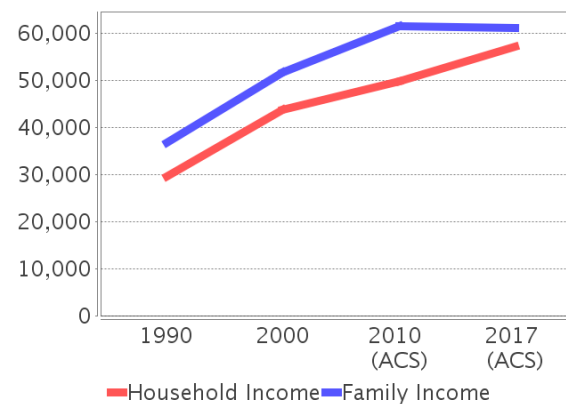

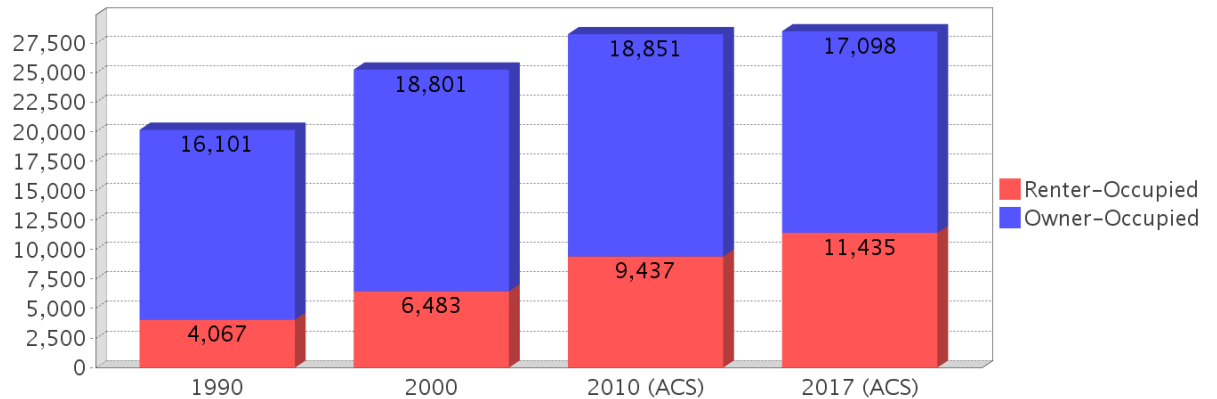

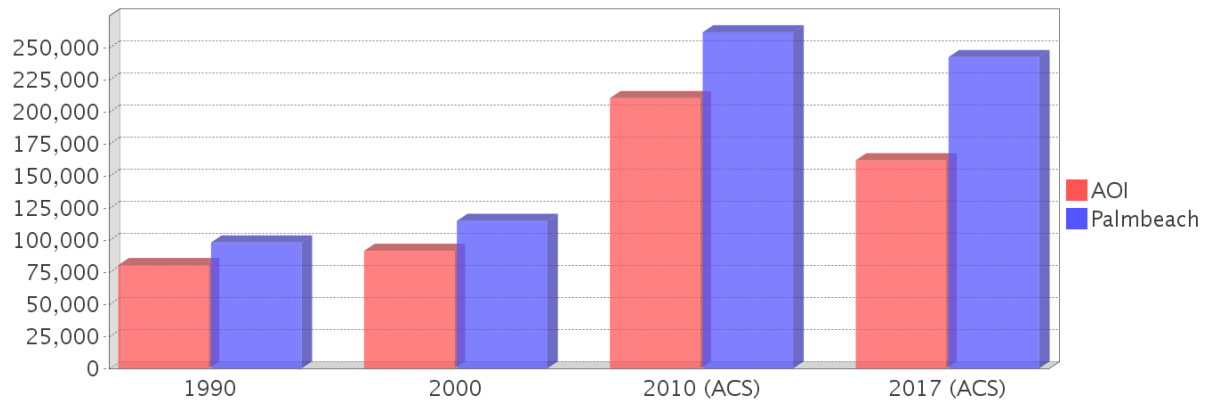

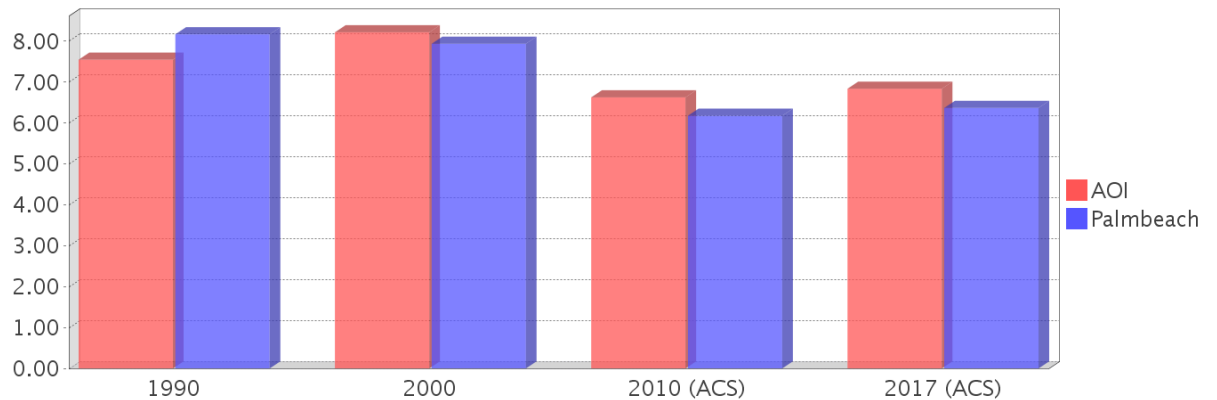
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

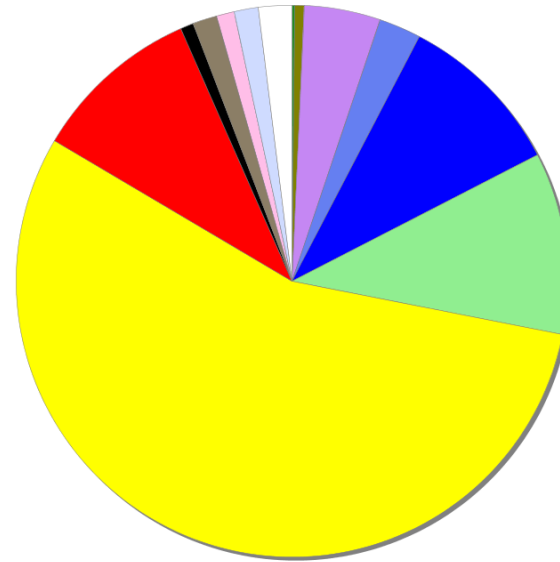


Occupied Units With No Vehicles Available



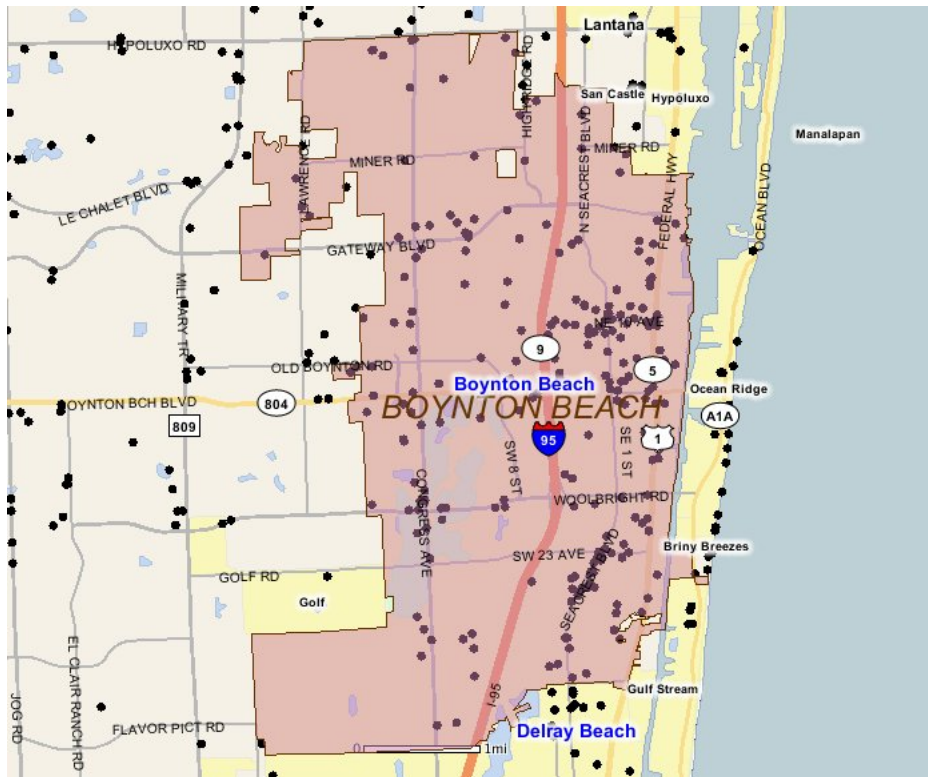

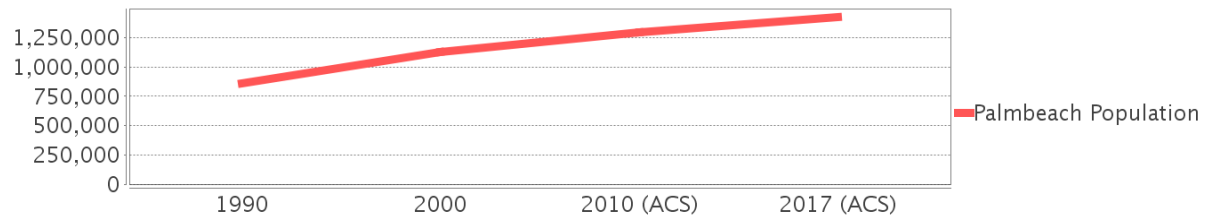

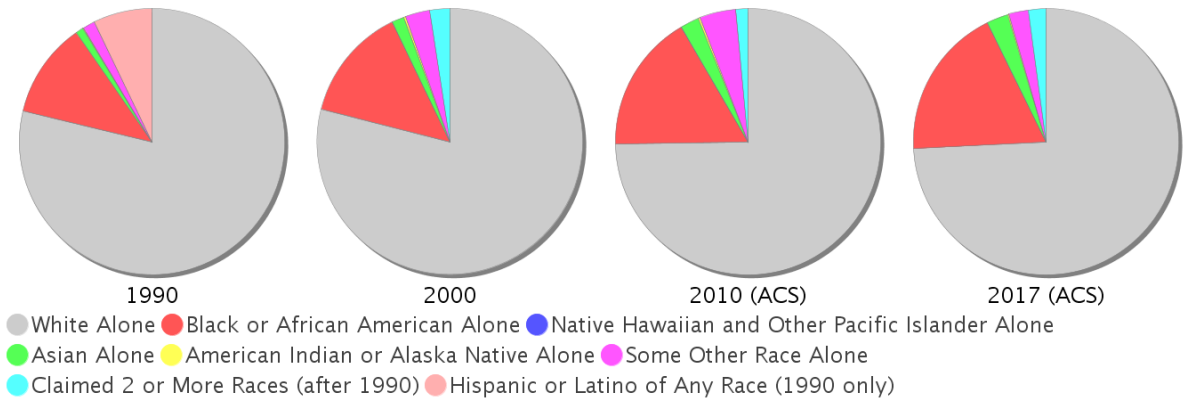

Palmbeach County Population



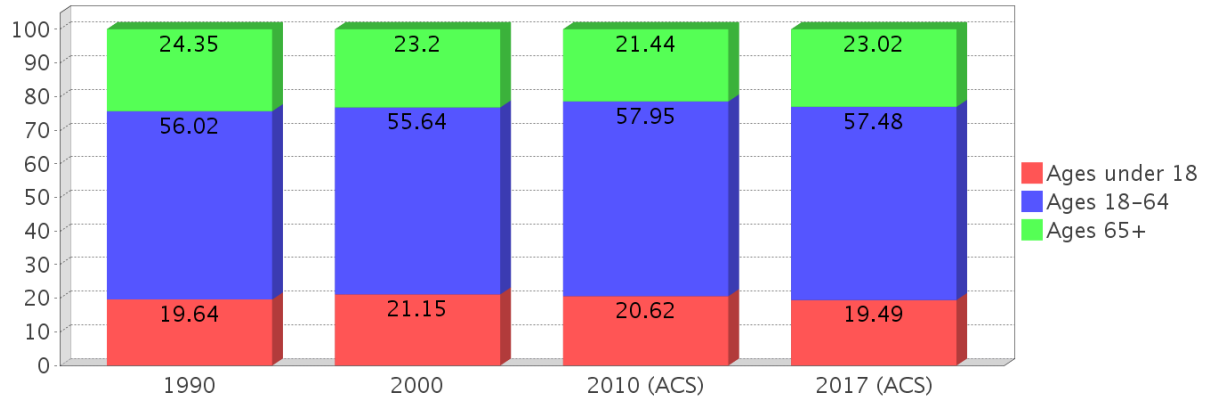

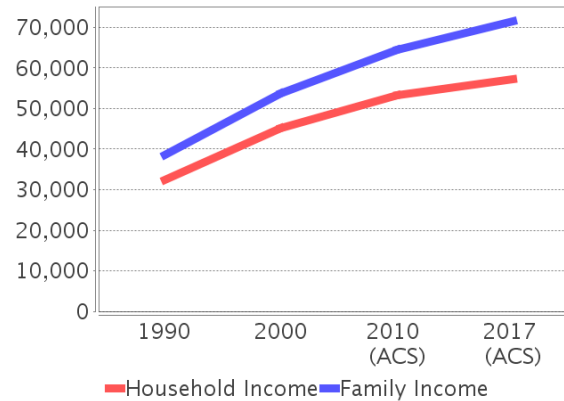
Percentage Population by Age Group - Palmbeach



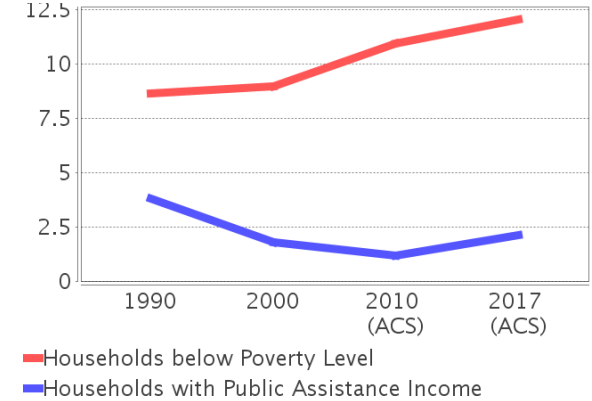

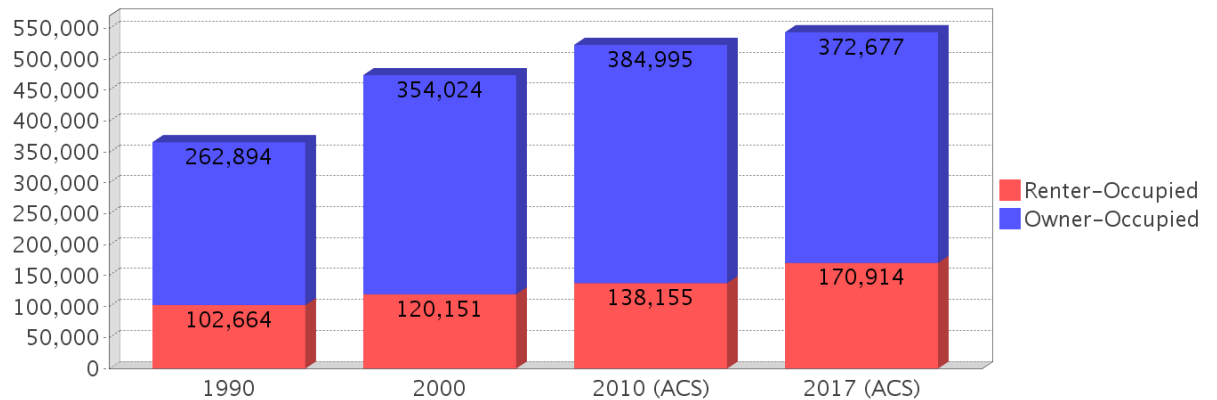
