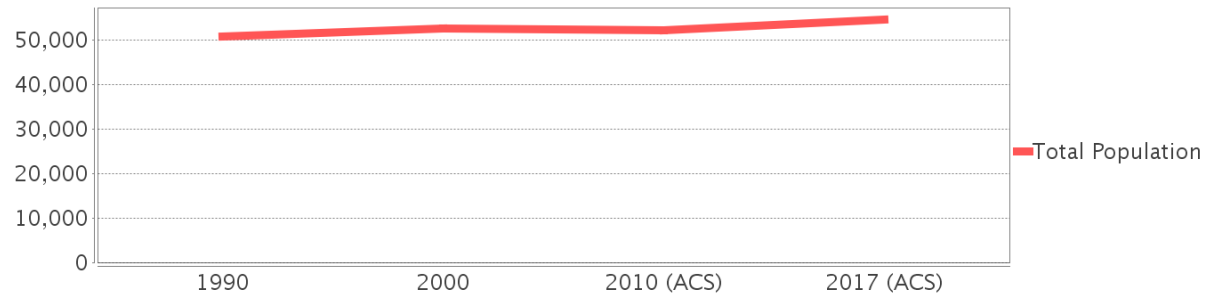

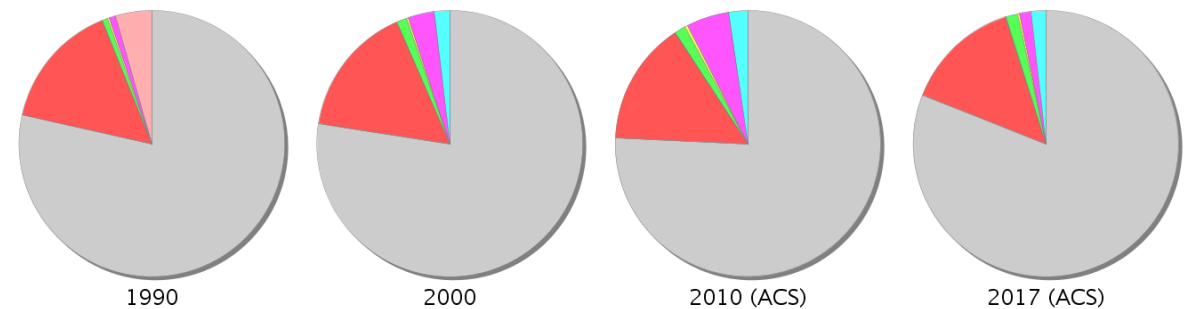

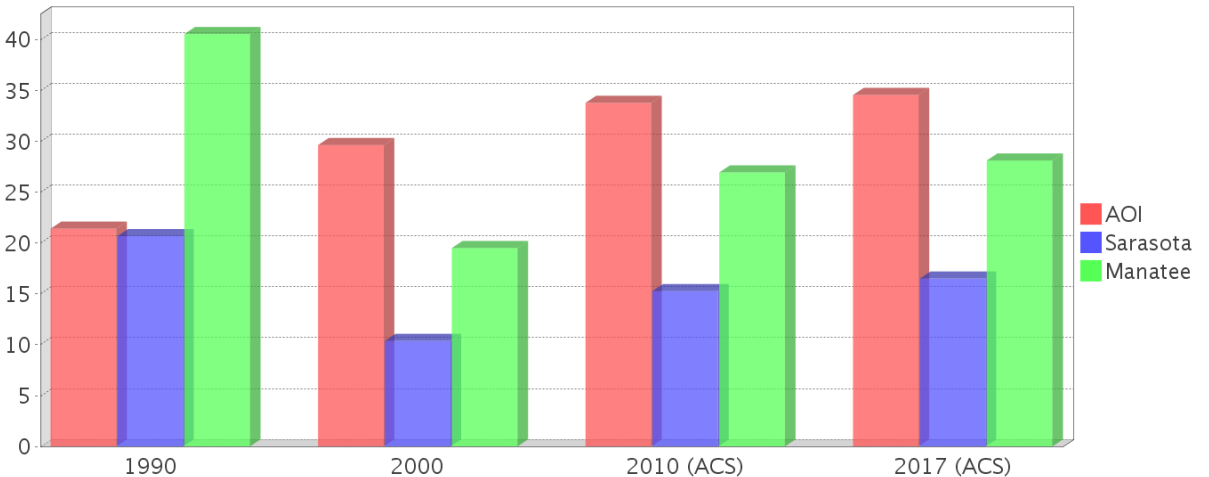

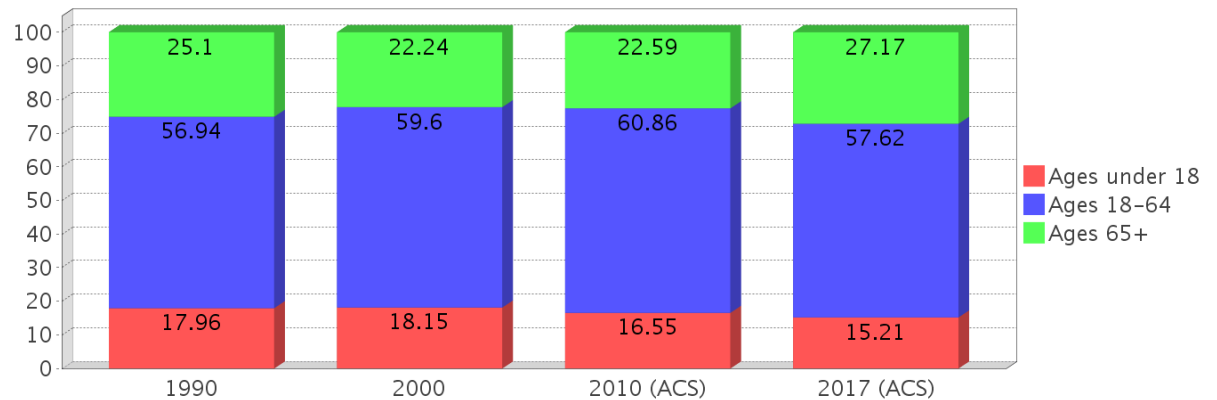

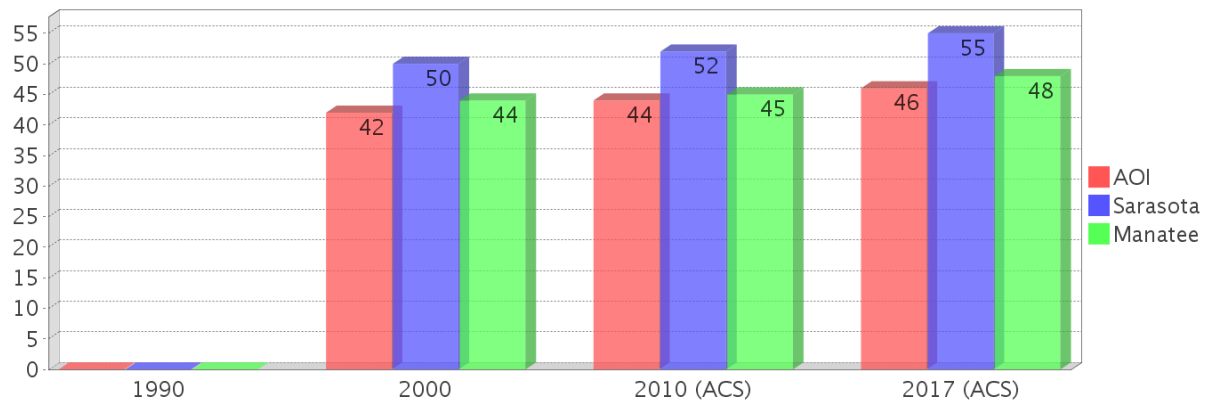
Percentage Population by Age Group

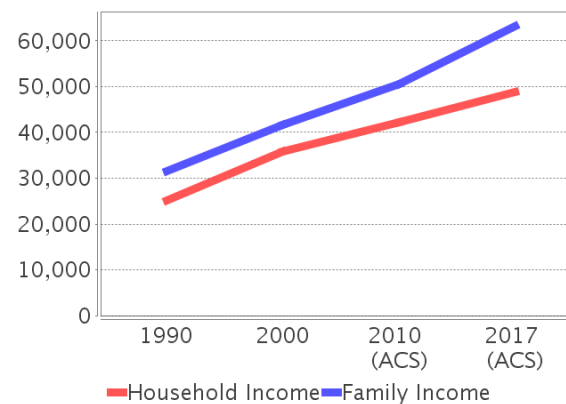

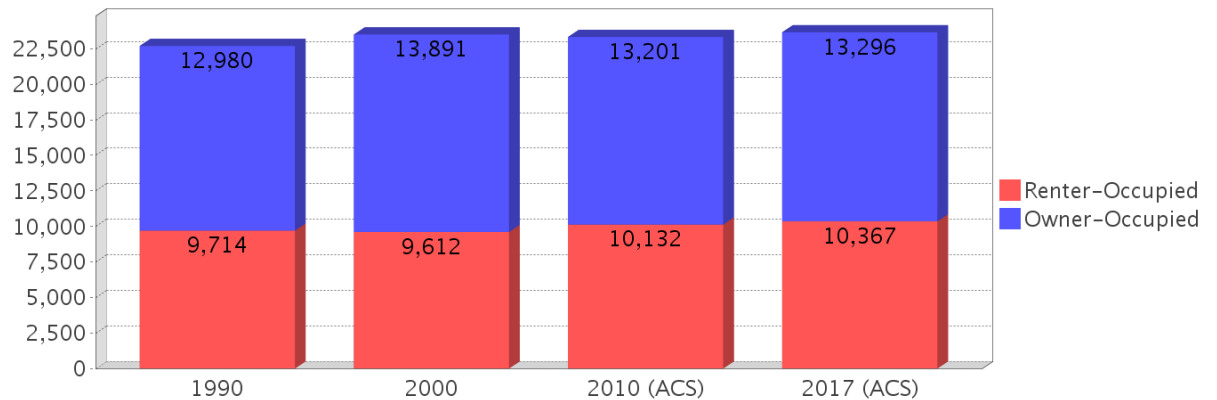

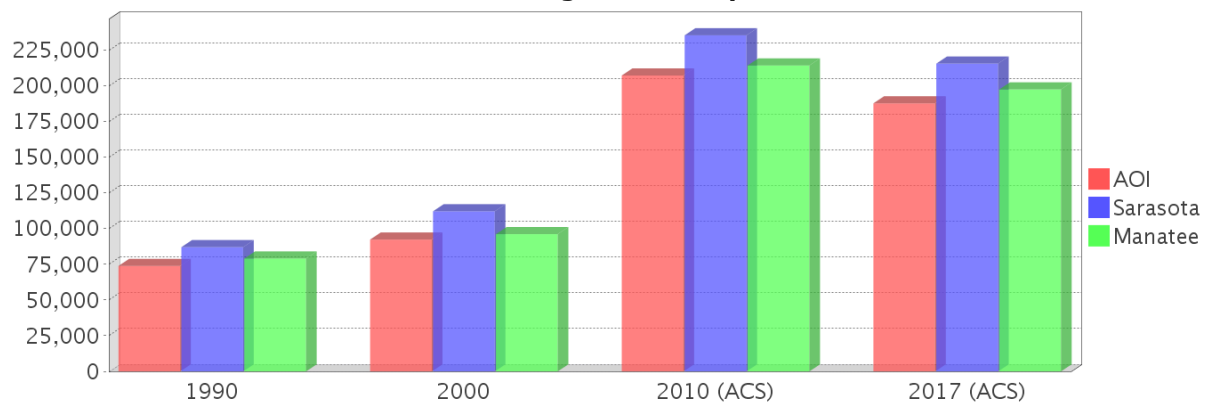

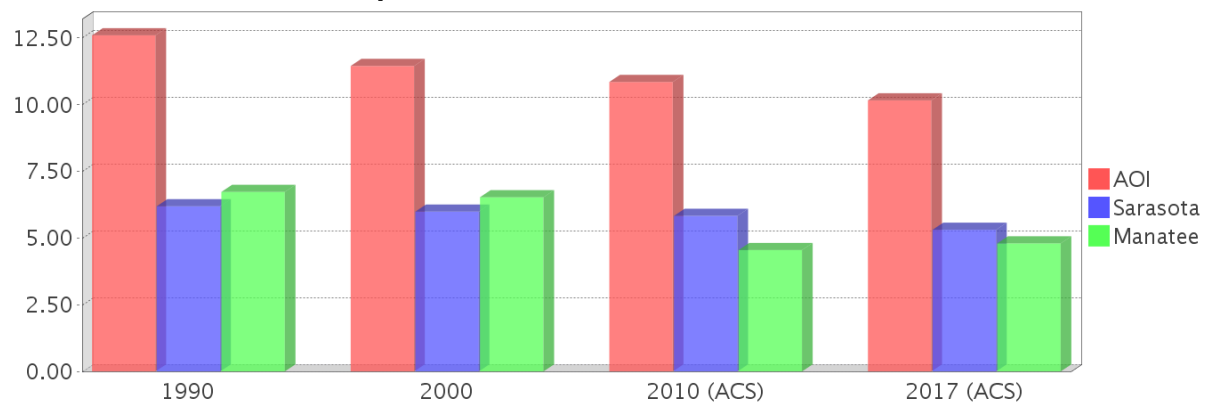
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

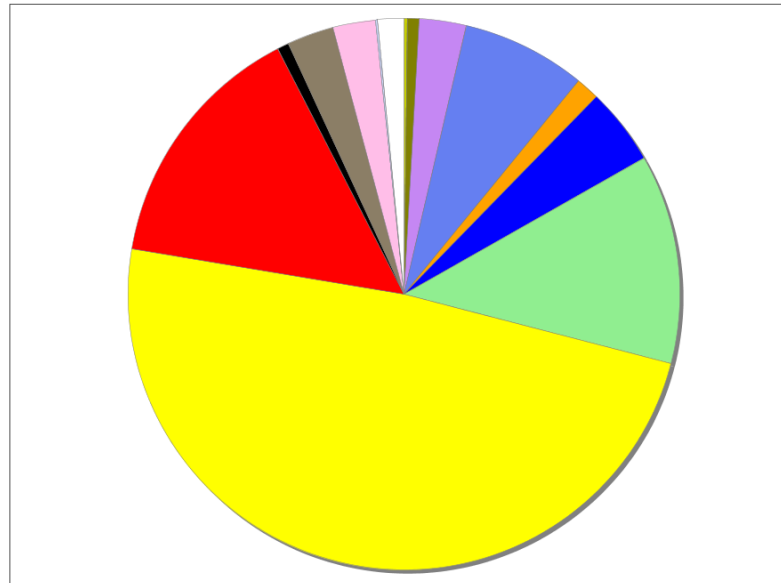


Occupied Units With No Vehicles Available



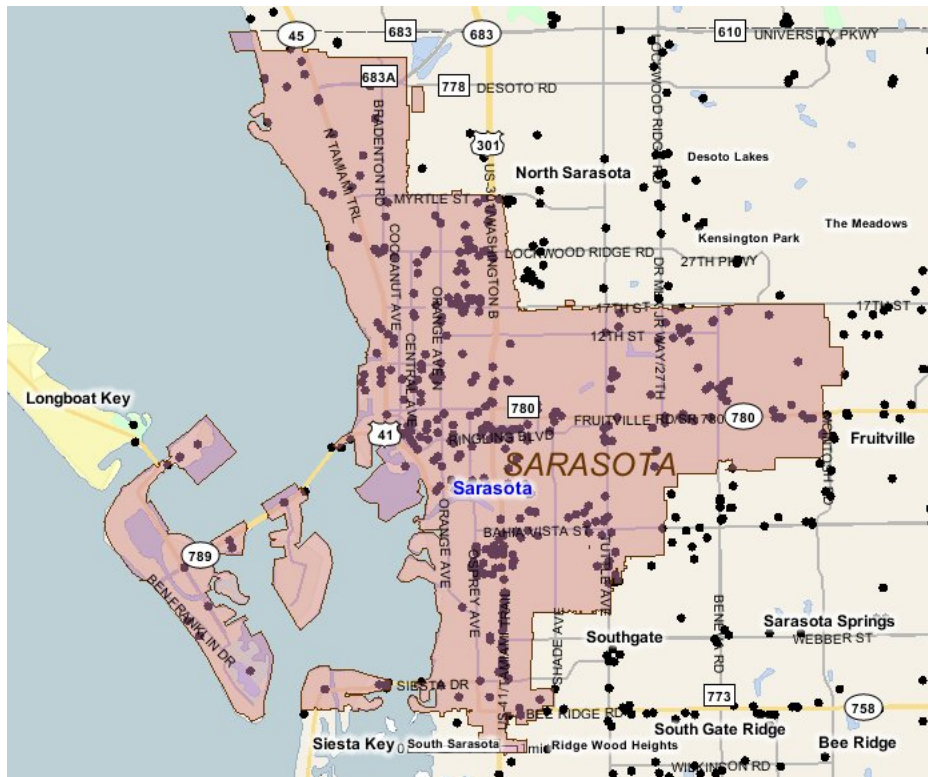

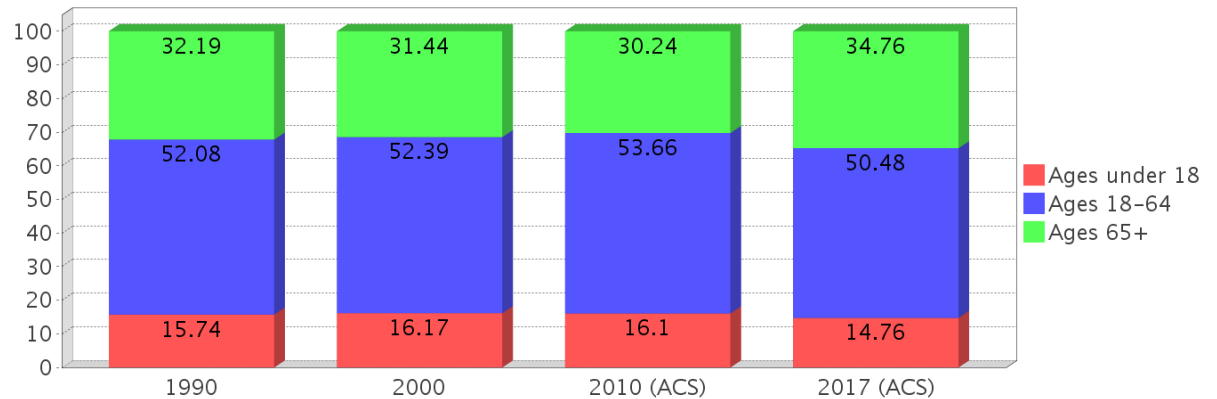

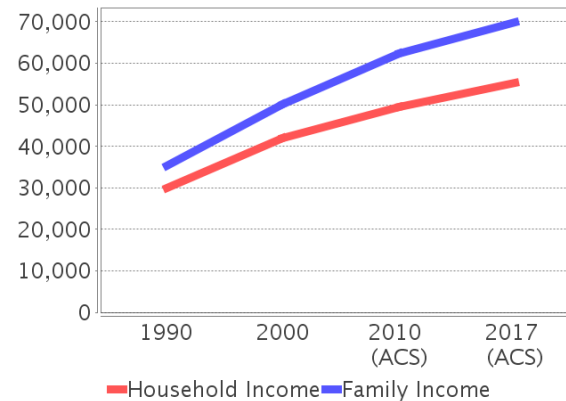
Percentage Population by Age Group - Sarasota



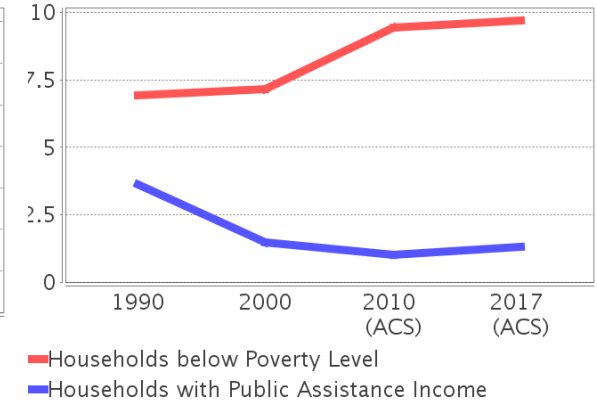

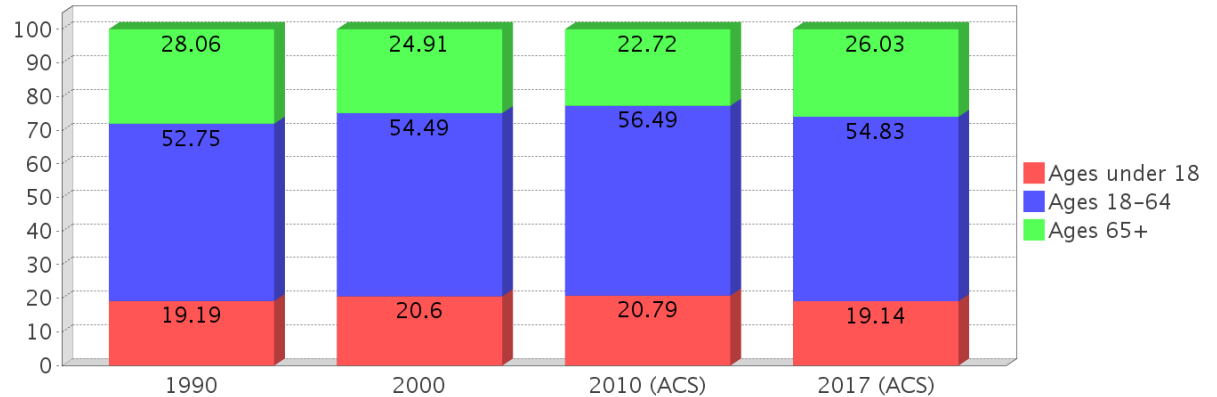

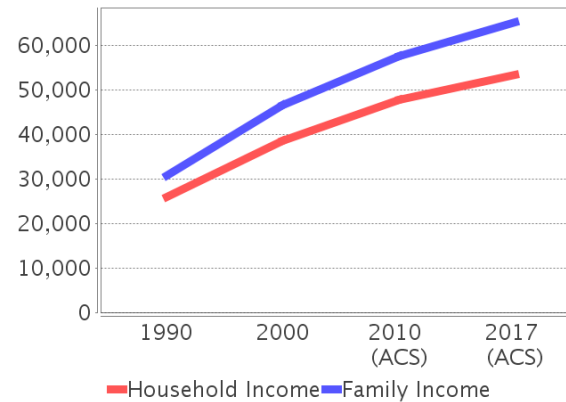
Percentage Population by Age Group - Manatee



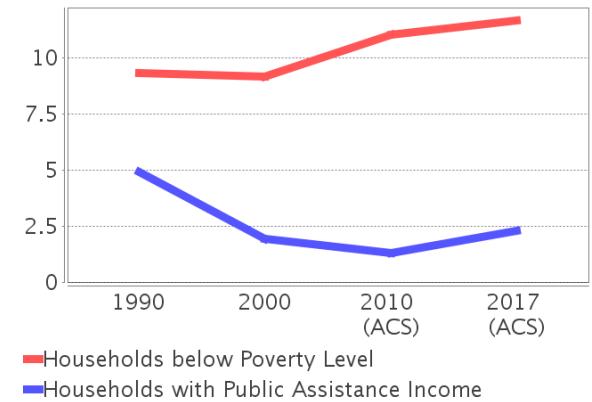

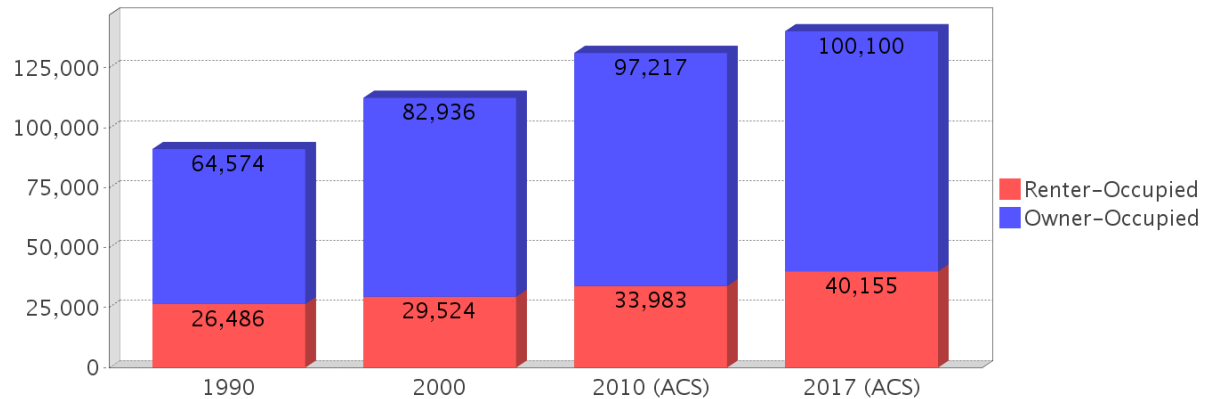
