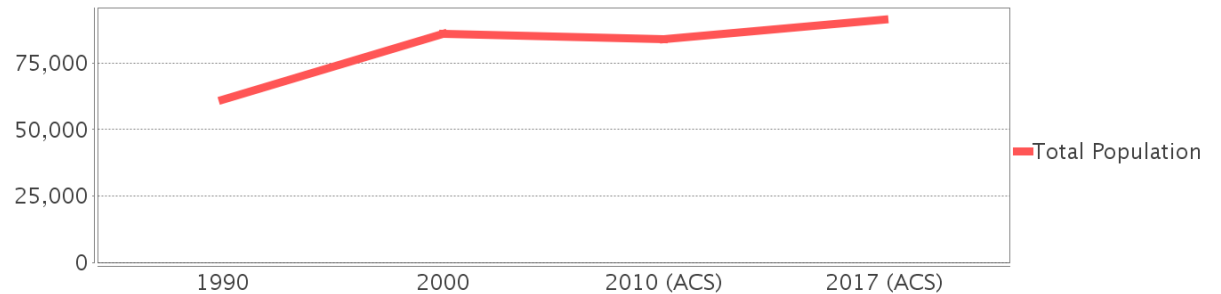

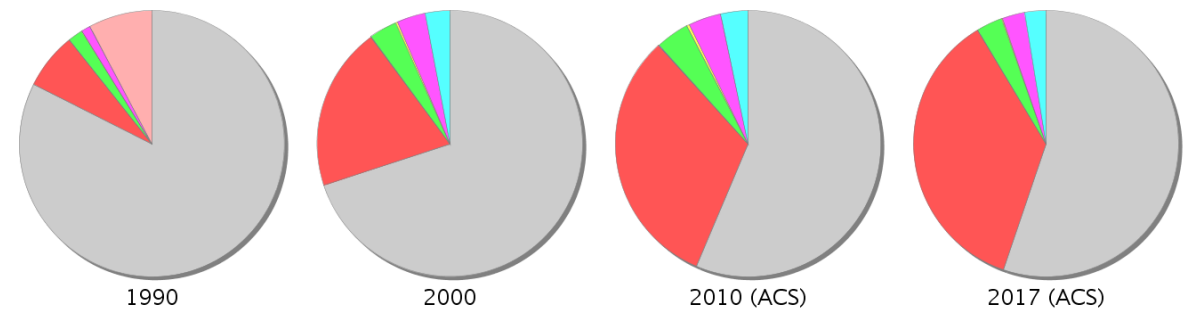

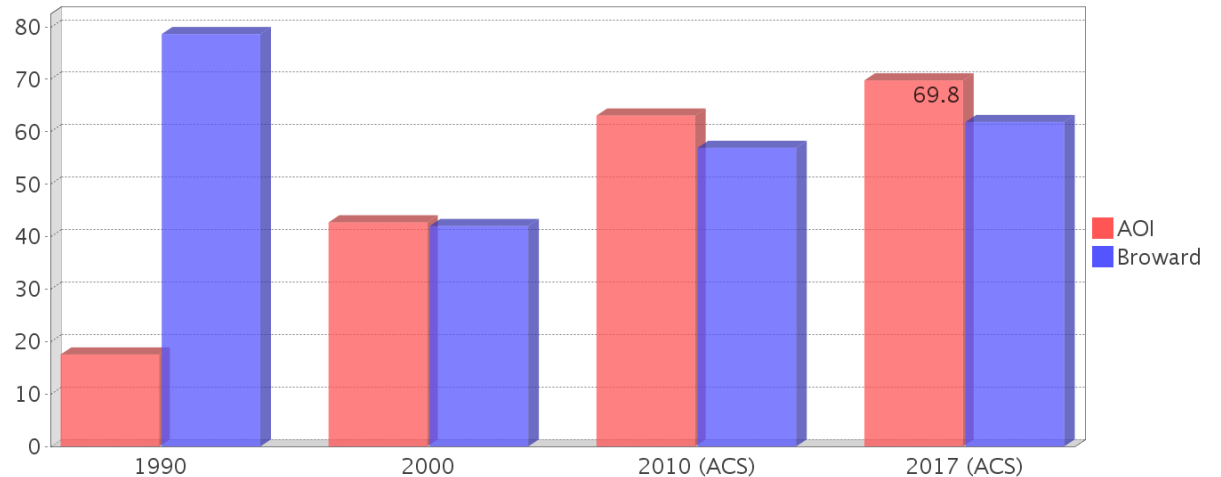

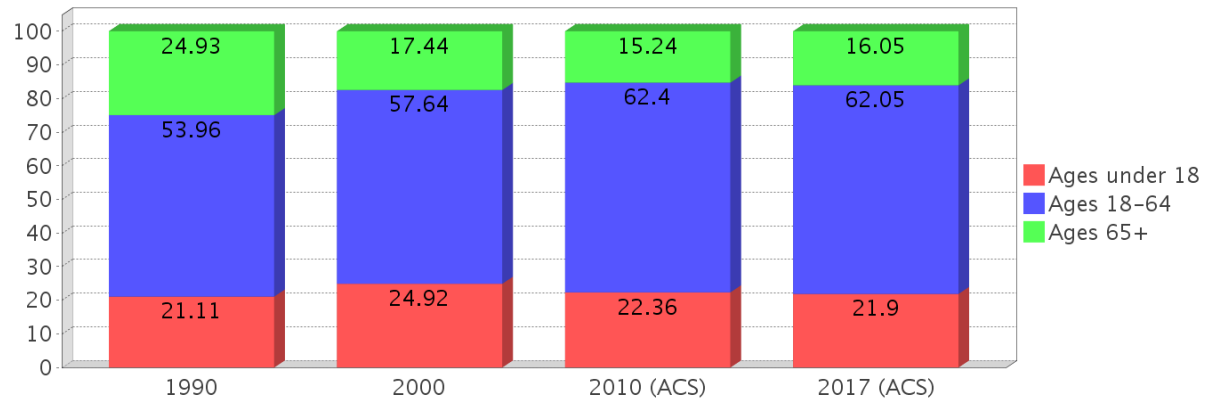

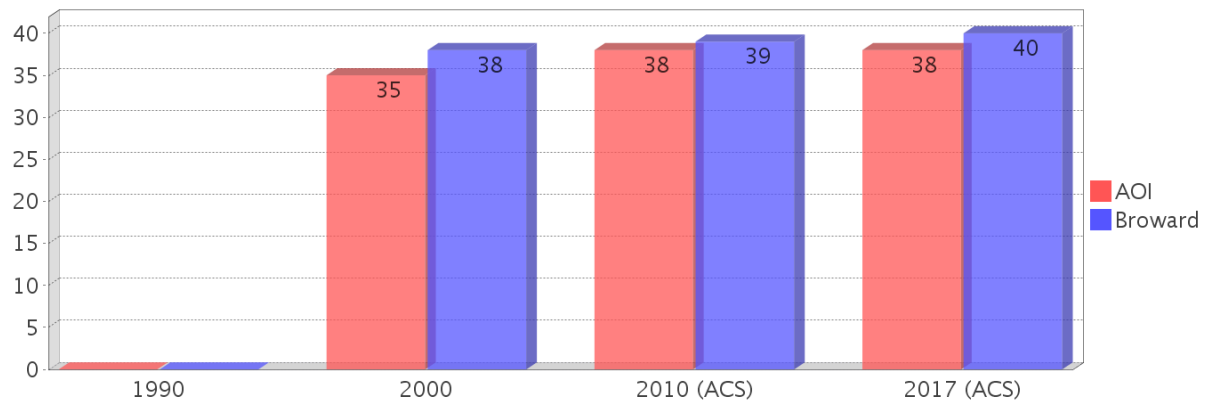
Percentage Population by Age Group

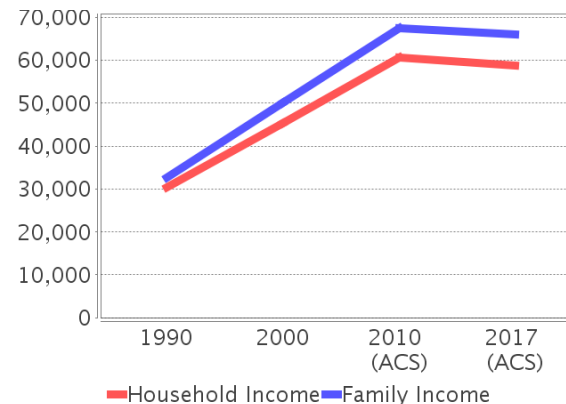

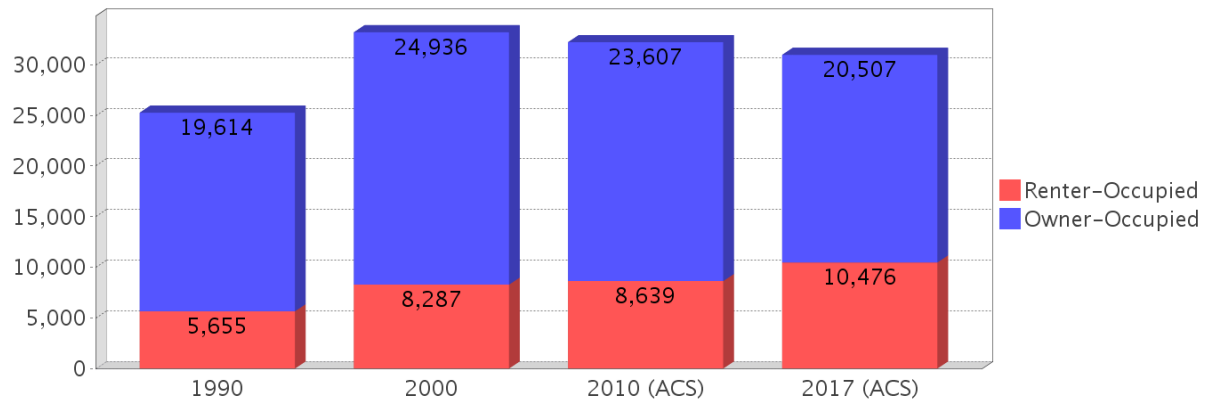

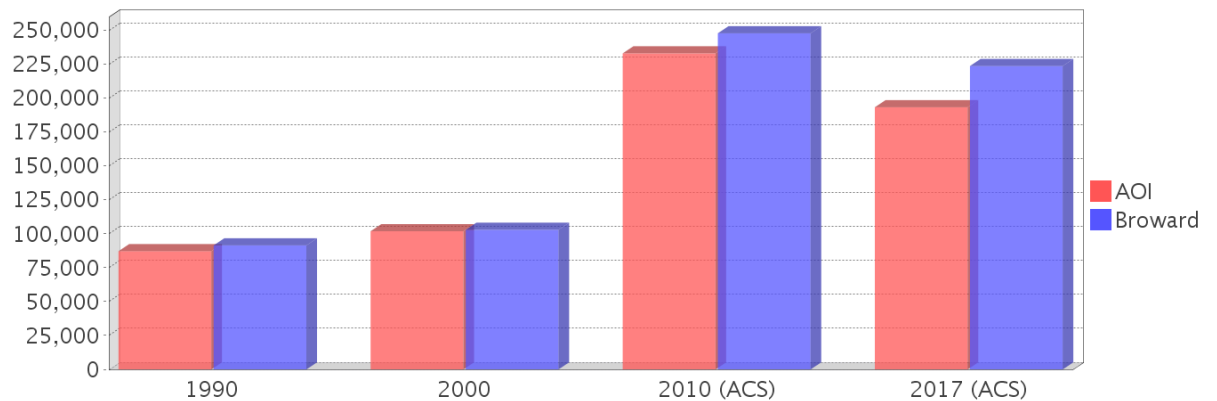

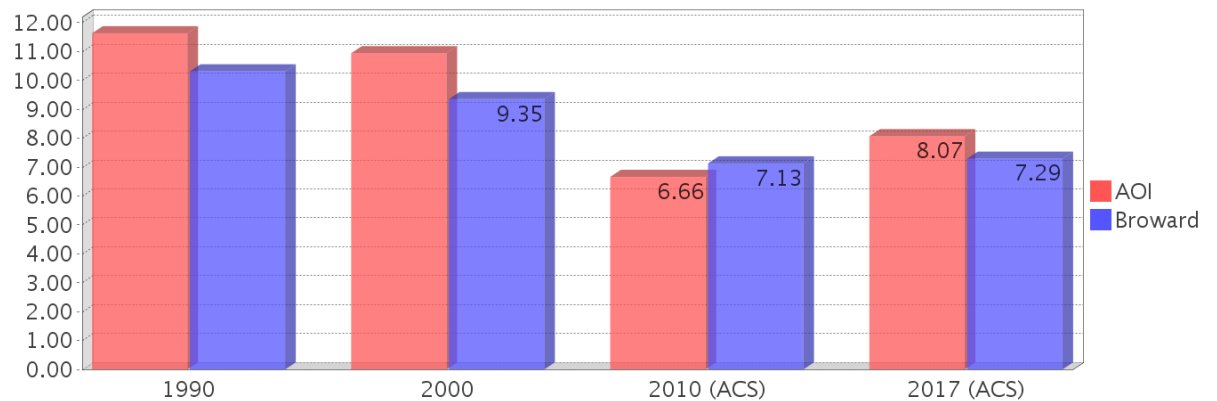
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

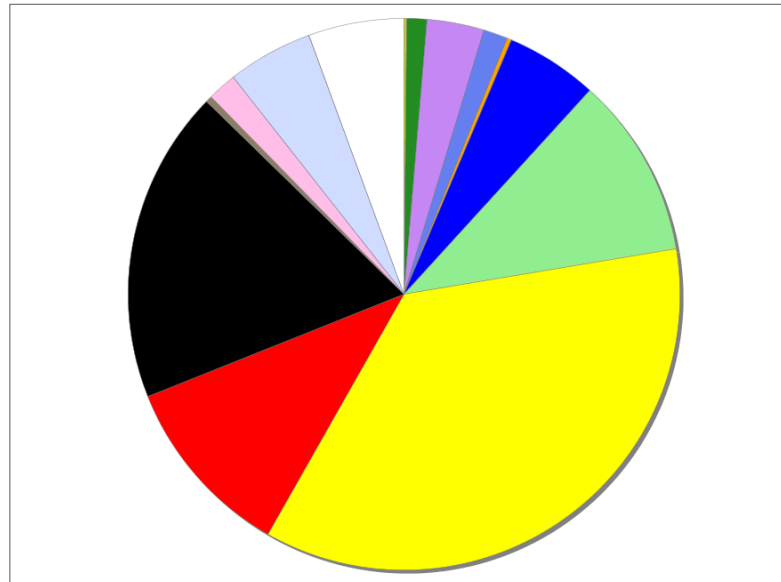


Occupied Units With No Vehicles Available



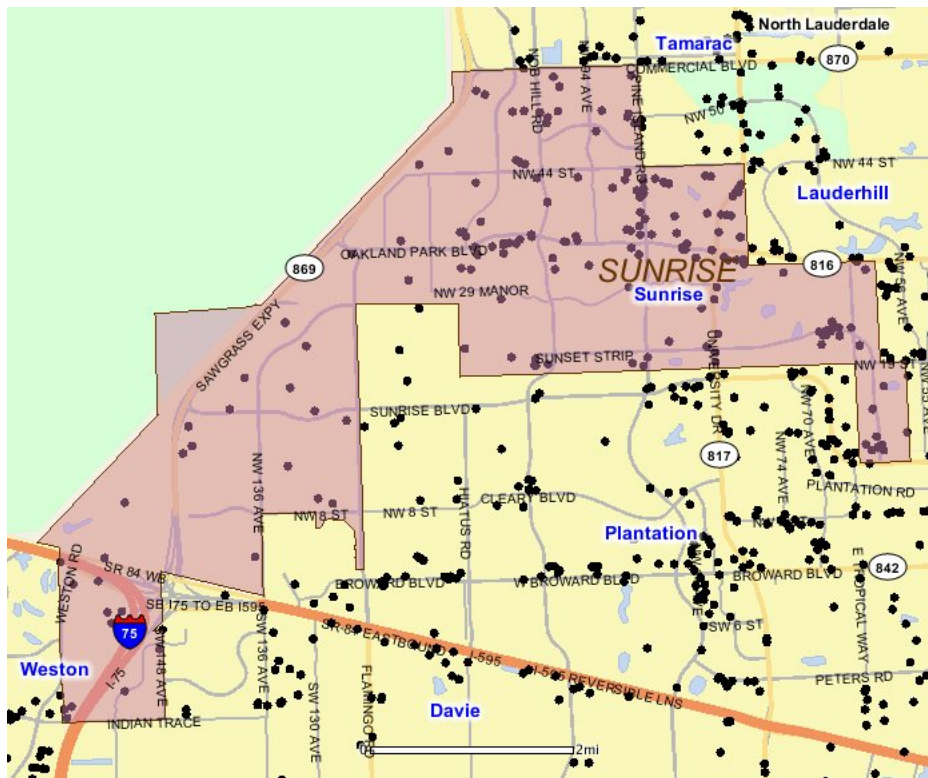

Jurisdiction

Jurisdiction(s) includes local government boundaries that intersect the community or AOI boundary.

Demographic data reported under the headings General Population Trends, Race and Ethnicity Trends, Age Trends, Income Trends, Educational Attainment Trends, Language Trends, and Housing Trends is from the U.S. Decennial Census (1990, 2000) and the American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year estimates from 2006-2010 and 2013-2017. 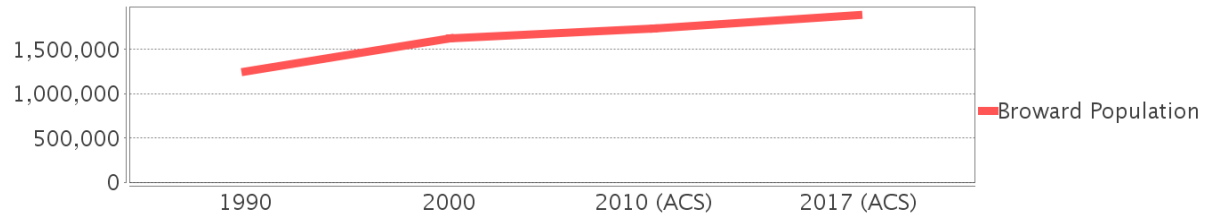

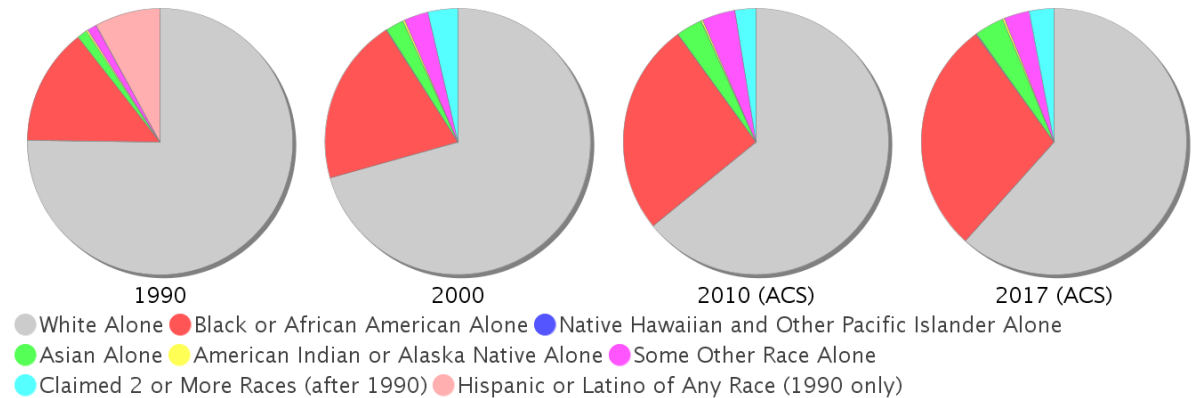

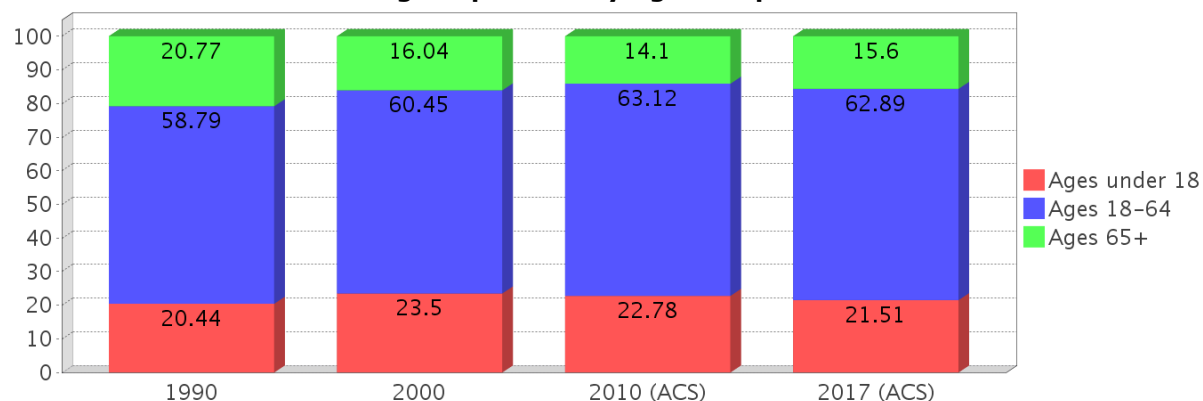

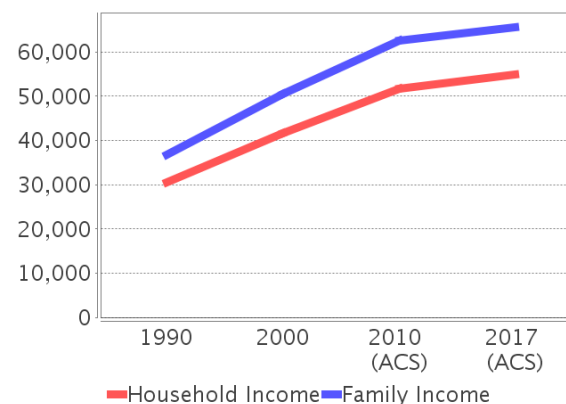
Percentage Population by Age Group - Broward



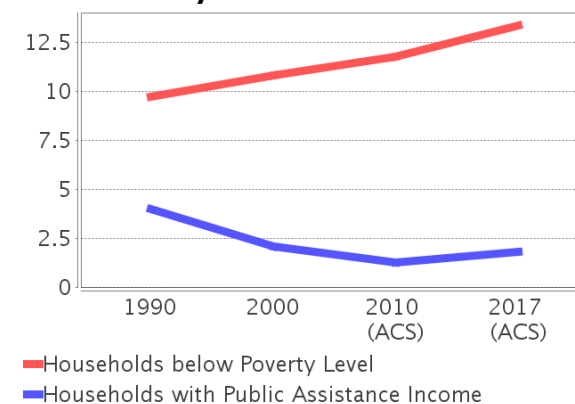

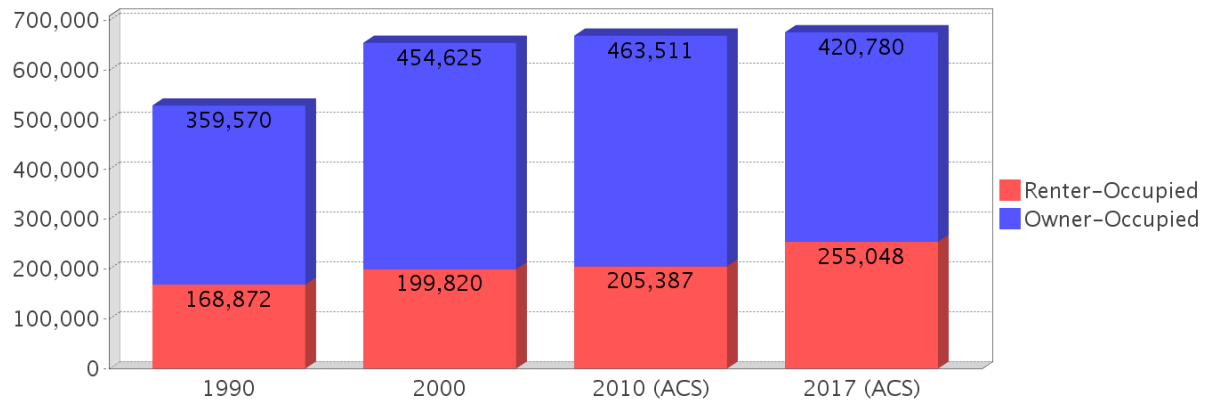
